

**APPLICATION FOR PERMISSION**  
**UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE TOWN PLANNING ORDINANCE**

**APPLICATION NO. A/YL-NTM/366**  
***(for 1<sup>st</sup> Deferment)***

- Applicant** : Famous Team (HK) Trading Limited represented by Good Power Management Consultant Limited
- Site** : Lots 22 (Part), 23 S.B, 24 S.B (Part), 25 S.C (Part), 40 (Part) in D.D. 98 and Adjoining Government Land, Ngau Tam Mei, Yuen Long
- Site Area** : About 1, 045m<sup>2</sup> (includes Government Land (GL) of about 110m<sup>2</sup>)
- Land Status** : Block Government Lease (demised for agricultural use)
- Plan** : Approved Ngau Tam Mei Outline Zoning Plan (OZP) No. S/YL-NTM/12
- Zoning** : “Open Storage” (“OS”)
- Application** : Proposed Temporary Cargo Handling and Forwarding Facility and Warehouse (excluding Dangerous Goods Godown)

**1. Background**

On 14.3.2018, the applicant submitted an application to seek planning permission for proposed temporary cargo handling and forwarding facility and warehouse (excluding dangerous goods godown) for a period of 3 years at the application site (**Plan A-1**). The application is scheduled for consideration by the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) on 4.5.2018.

**2. Request for Deferment**

On 16.4.2018, the applicant’s agent wrote to the Secretary of the Town Planning Board (the Board) and requested the Board to defer making a decision on the application in order to allow two months’ time for the applicant to prepare further information to address comments of concerned Government departments (**Appendix I**).

**3. Planning Department's Views**

- 3.1 The Planning Department has no objection to the request for deferment as the justification for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33) in that the applicant needs more time to prepare further information in response to departmental comments, the deferment period is not indefinite and the deferment would not affect the interests of other relevant parties.
- 3.2 Should the Committee agree to defer making a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of further submission from the applicant. If the further information submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. The applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed two months for preparation of submission of further information, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances.

**4. Decision Sought**

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration at the next meeting.
