### 1. Background

**Applicant** 

- 1.1 The applicant seeks planning permission for proposed goods compartment assembling workshop for light goods vehicle for a period of 3 years at the application site (**Plan A-1**). On 3.8.2018, the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) agreed to defer making a decision on the application, as requested by the applicant, to allow two months' time for the applicant to prepare further information (FI) to address the comments of relevant departments.
- 1.2 On 10.8.2018, the applicant submitted revised drainage proposal and responses to address comments from Agricultural, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) and Drainage Services Department (DSD). The application is scheduled for consideration by the Committee on 21.9.2018

### 2. Request for Deferment

On 6.9.2018, the applicant's agent wrote to the Secretary of the Town Planning Board (the Board) and requested the Board to defer making a decision on the application so as to allow 2 months' time for the applicant to prepare FI to address comments received from

DSD and Planning Department (PlanD) (Appendix I).

#### 3. Planning Department's Views

- 3.1 The application has been deferred once at the request of the applicant to allow 2 months' time for preparation of FI to address departmental comments. Since the first deferment on 3.8.2018, the applicant submitted FI on 10.8.2018 in response to the comments from AFCD and DSD. However, the applicant needs more time to prepare FI to address the further comments received from DSD and PlanD.
- 3.2 The Planning Department <u>has no objection</u> to the request for deferment as the justification for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33) in that the applicant needs more time to prepare FI in response to departmental comments, the deferment period is not indefinite and the deferment would not affect the interests of other relevant parties.
- 3.3 Should the Committee agree to defer making a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of FI from the applicant. If the FI submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. Since it is the second deferment of the application, the applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed a total of four months for preparation of submission of FI, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances.

#### 4. Decision Sought

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration at the next meeting.
