## 1. Background

On 2.10.2019, the applicant sought planning permission to use the application site (the Site) for proposed solar energy system (**Plan A-1**). On 29.11.2019, the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) of the Town Planning Board (the Board) decided to defer a decision on the application, pending the formulation of assessment criteria on applications for installation of solar energy system. The set of Assessment Criteria for Considering Applications for Solar Photovoltaic (the Assessment Criteria) was promulgated on 17.7.2020.

#### 2. Request for Deferment

On 28.7.2020, the applicant wrote to the Secretary of the Board and requested the Board to defer making a decision on the application for two months in order to allow time to study if additional information would be required to support the application (**Appendix I**).

#### 3. Planning Department's Views

3.1 The Planning Department <u>has no objection</u> to the request for deferment as the justification for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board

Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33) in that the applicant needs more time to prepare important supplementary information to support the application, the deferment period is not indefinite, and the deferment would not affect the interests of other relevant parties.

3.2 Should the Committee agree to defer a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of further submission from the applicant. If the further information submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. The applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed a period of two months for preparation of submission of further information, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances.

# 4. Decision Sought

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted for the Committee's consideration at the next meeting.
