1. <u>Background</u>

- 1.1 On 19.6.2018, the applicant seeks planning permission for religious institution and columbarium with ancillary quarters on the application site (the Site) (**Plan A-1**).
- 1.2 On 17.8.2018 and 19.10.2018, the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) of the Town Planning Board (the Board) agreed to defer a decision on the application each for two months, as requested by the applicant's representative, to allow time for the applicant to prepare further information (FI) in support of the application. The application is scheduled for consideration by the Committee on 18.1.2019.

2. <u>Request for Deferment</u>

On 21.12.2018, the representative of the applicant wrote to the Secretary of the Board and requested the Board to further defer making a decision on the application for another two months so as to allow time for preparation of further information to address Transport Department (TD) and Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD)'s comments (**Appendix I**).

3. <u>Planning Department's Views</u>

- 3.1 The application has been deferred twice for a total period of four months at the request of the applicant to allow more time to address departmental comments. The applicant has all along demonstrated efforts in submitting FIs to address departmental comments. Since the last deferment, the applicant has submitted FI a traffic impact assessment (TIA). In order to allow more time to address TD's comments on the TIA and FEHD's comments regarding the licensing application under the Private Columbarium Ordinance, the applicant requests the Board to defer a decision on the application for further two months.
- 3.2 The Planning Department <u>has no objection</u> to the request for deferment as the justification for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33) in that the applicant needs more time to conduct a TIA in response to TD's comments, the deferment period is not indefinite and the deferment would not affect the interests of other relevant parties.
- 3.3 Should the Committee agree to defer making a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of further submission from the applicant. If the FI submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. Since it is the third deferment of the application and the Committee has allowed a total of six months for preparation of submission of FI this is the last deferment and no further deferment would be granted.

4. <u>Decision Sought</u>

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration at the next meeting.
