## Relevant extracts of the Town Planning Board Guidelines for <u>Application for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses</u> (TPB PG-No.13E)

- 1. On 17.10.2008, the Town Planning Board Guidelines for Application for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses under Section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 13E) were promulgated, which set out the following criteria for the various categories of area:
  - (a) Category 1 areas: favourable consideration will normally be given to applications within these areas, subject to no major adverse departmental comments and local objections, or the concerns of the departments and local residents can be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions. Technical assessments should be submitted if the proposed uses may cause significant environmental and traffic concerns;
  - (b) Category 2 areas: planning permission could be granted on a temporary basis up to a maximum period of 3 years, subject to no adverse departmental comments and local objections, or the concerns of the departments and local residents can be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions. Technical assessments, where appropriate, should be submitted to demonstrate that the proposed uses would not have adverse drainage, traffic, visual, landscaping and environmental impacts on the surrounding areas;
  - (c) Category 3 areas: applications would normally not be favorably considered unless the applications are on sites with previous planning approvals. Sympathetic consideration may be given if the applicants have demonstrated genuine efforts in compliance with approval conditions of the previous planning applications and included in the fresh applications relevant technical assessments/proposals to demonstrate that the proposed uses would not generate adverse drainage, traffic, visual, landscaping and environmental impacts on the surrounding areas. Planning permission could be granted on a temporary basis up to a maximum period of 3 years, subject to no adverse departmental comments and local objections, or the concerns of the departments and local residents can be addressed through the implementation of approval conditions; and
  - (d) Category 4 areas: applications would normally be rejected except under exceptional circumstances. For applications on sites with previous planning approvals, and subject to no adverse departmental comments and local objections, sympathetic consideration may be given if the applicants have demonstrated genuine efforts in compliance with approval conditions of the previous planning applications and included in the applications relevant technical assessments/proposals to demonstrate that the proposed uses would not generate adverse drainage, traffic, visual, landscaping and environmental impacts on the surrounding areas. The intention is however to encourage the phasing out of such non-conforming uses as early as possible. A maximum period of 2 years may be allowed upon renewal of planning permission for an applicant to identify suitable sites for relocation. No further renewal of approval will be given unless under very exceptional circumstances and each application for renewal of approval will be assessed on its individual merit.

- 2. In assessing applications for open storage and port back-up uses, the other major relevant assessment criteria are also summarized as follows:
  - (a) there will be a general presumption against development on sites of less than 1,000 m<sup>2</sup> for open storage uses and 2,000 m<sup>2</sup> for port back-up uses in rural areas, other than sites located in major corridors, industrial/godown/workshop areas, quarrying activities or where it is demonstrated that optimum use is made of the site. This is to prevent the further proliferation of small sites in rural areas, minimizing sprawl over countryside areas and reducing travel trips;
  - (b) port back-up sites and those types of open storage uses generating adverse noise, air pollution and visual intrusion and frequent heavy vehicle traffic should not be located adjacent to sensitive receivers such as residential dwellings, hospitals, schools and other community facilities;
  - (c) port back-up uses are major generators of traffic, with container trailer/tractor parks generating the highest traffic per unit area. In general, port back-up sites should have good access to the strategic road network, or be accessed by means of purpose built roads;
  - (d) adequate screening of the sites through landscaping and/or fencing should be provided where sites are located adjacent to public roads or are visible from surrounding residential areas;
  - (e) there is a general presumption against conversion of agricultural land and fish ponds to other uses on an ad hoc basis, particularly in flood prone areas or sites which would obstruct natural drainage channels and overland flow; and
  - (f) for applications involving sites with previous planning approvals, should there be no evidence to demonstrate that the applicants have made any genuine effort to comply with the approval conditions of the previous planning applications, planning permission may be refused, or a shorter compliance period for the approval conditions may be imposed, notwithstanding other criteria set out in the Guidelines are complied with.

- (1) No night-time operation 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. is allowed.
- (2) No operation on Sundays and public holidays is allowed.
- (3) No container tractors, trailers or containers are allowed to be stored/parked on the site.
- (4) No storage at the open area of the site.
- (5) No repairing/ cleaning/dismantling and workshop activities are allowed to be carried out on the site.
- (6) No medium or heavy goods vehicles over 5.5 tonnes (including container tractor/trailer) are allowed for the operation of the site.
- (7) No parking, queuing and reverse movement of vehicles on public road are allowed
- (8) The stacking height of the materials stored within 5m of the periphery of the site should not exceed the height of the boundary fence.
- (9) Provision of periphery fencing for the site.
- (10) Implementation of accepted landscape proposal.
- (11) Submission and implementation of tree preservation and landscape proposals.
- (12) Submission and implementation of drainage proposal.
- (13) Submission of a record of the existing drainage facilities on the site.
- (14) Implementation of accepted drainage proposal.
- (15) Submission and implementation of fire service installations proposal.
- (16) Provision of fire extinguisher(s).
- (17) Maintenance of the existing boundary fence on the site.

- (18) Maintenance of the existing landscape planting on the site.
- (19) Maintenance of the existing drainage facilities on the site.
- (20) Maintenance of the implemented drainage facilities on the site.

## **Detailed Departmental Comments**

## Comments of the Chief Town Planner/Urban Design and Landscape, Planning Department:

- (a) The applicant is reminded to conduct routine vegetation maintenance works, such as irrigating the trees and removing weeds regularly throughout the period. Fence and/or kerb or bollard should be constructed with a minimum distance of 1 m around the planting areas to guard against damage to the trees and shrubs. The applicant should make reference to "Technical Note on the Submission and Implementation of Landscape Proposals for Compliance with Conditions for Approved Applications for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses under Section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance".
- (b) The applicant should take reference to the following information/guidelines published by the GLTM Section, Development Bureau for tree maintenance:-
  - (i) Information About Tree Maintenance For Private Properties: (https://www.greening.gov.hk/tc/tree\_care/Handbook\_on\_Tree\_Manage ment.html); and
  - (ii) Pictorial Guide for Tree Maintenance : (https://www.greening.gov.hk/filemanager/content/pdf/tree\_care/Pictoria 1 Guide for Tree Management.pdf).

#### **Advisory Clauses**

- (a) prior planning permission should have been obtained before continuing the applied use on Site;
- (b) to resolve any land issues relating to the development with the concerned owner(s) at the Site;
- (c) the Site should be kept in a clean and tidy condition at all times;
- (d) to note the comments of the District Lands Officer/Yuen Long, Lands Department (DLO/YL, LandsD) that the private lots within the site are Old Scheduled Agricultural Lots held under Block Government Lease under which no structures are allowed to be erected without prior approval from his office. Within the Site, the private lots are currently covered by Short Term Waivers (STWs) Nos. 3949, 4321, 3950, 4322, 4749 and 4323 generally for temporary open storage/warehouse of construction machinery, construction materials and metal ware with ancillary site office. The Site is accessible through an informal track on Government land and private land extended from Kung Um Road. Her office does not provide maintenance works for Government land involved nor guarantee any right-of-way. The Site does not fall within Shek Kong Airfield Height Restriction Area. The STW holder(s) will need to apply to her office for modification of the STW conditions if there are any irregularities on Site. Such application(s) will be considered by LandsD acting in the capacity as landlord or lessor at its sole discretion and there is no guarantee that such application(s) will be approved. If such application(s) is approved, it will be subject to such terms and conditions, including among others the payment of premium or fee, as may be imposed by LandsD;
- (e) to note the comments of the Commissioner for Transport that the land status of the road/path/track leading to the Site from Kung Um Road should be checked with the lands authority. The management and maintenance responsibilities of the same road/path/track should be clarified with the relevant lands and maintenance authorities accordingly. The applicant is reminded that sufficient space should be provided within the Site for manoeuvring of vehicles. In addition, no parking, queuing and no reverse movement of vehicles on public road are allowed;
- (f) to note the comments of the Chief Highway Engineer/New Territories West, Highways Department that adequate drainage measures should be provided at the Site access to prevent surface water running from the Site to the nearby public roads and drains. His Department shall not be responsible for the maintenance of any access connecting the Site and Kung Um Road;
- (g) to follow the latest "Code of Practice on Handling the Environmental Aspects of Temporary uses and Open Storages Sites" issued by the Environment Protection Department to minimize any potential environmental nuisances;
- (h) to note the comments of the Chief Town Planner/Urban Design and Landscape, Planning Department that the applicant is reminded to conduct routine vegetation maintenance works, such as irrigating the trees and removing weeds regularly throughout the period. Fence and/or kerb or bollard should be constructed with a minimum distance of 1 m around the planting areas to guard against damage to the trees and shrubs. The applicant should make

reference to "Technical Note on the Submission and Implementation of Landscape Proposals for Compliance with Conditions for Approved Applications for Open Storage and Port Back-up Uses under Section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance". The applicant should take reference to the following information/guidelines published by the GLTM Section, Development Bureau for tree maintenance:-

- (a) Information About Tree Maintenance For Private Properties: (https://www.greening.gov.hk/tc/tree\_care/Handbook\_on\_Tree\_Management.html)
- (b) Pictorial Guide for Tree Maintenance: (https://www.greening.gov.hk/filemanager/content/pdf/tree\_care/Pictorial\_ Guide\_for\_ \_Tree\_Management.pdf);
- to note the comments of the Chief Building Surveyor/New Territories West, Buildings (i) Department (BD) that if the existing structures are erected on leased land without approval of BD (not being a New Territories Exempted House), they are unauthorized building works (UBW) under the Buildings Ordinance (BO) and should not be designated for any approved use under the subject application. For UBW erected on leased land, enforcement action may be taken by the BD to effect their removal in accordance with BD's enforcement policy against UBW as and when necessary. The granting of planning approval should not be construed as an acceptance of any existing building works or UBW on the Site under the BO. Before any new building works (including containers/open sheds as temporary buildings and land filling) are to be carried out on the Site, prior approval and consent of the BD should be obtained, otherwise they are UBW. An Authorized Person should be appointed as the co-ordinator for the proposed building works in accordance with the BO. The Site shall be provided with means of obtaining access thereto from a street and emergency vehicular access in accordance with Regulation 5 and 41D of the Building (Planning) Regulations (B(P)R) respectively. If the Site does not abut on a specified street of not less than 4.5m wide, its permitted development intensity shall be determined under Regulation 19(3) of B(P)R at the building plan submission stage;
- (j) to note the Director of Fire Services's comments that the applicant is advised to submit relevant layout plans incorporated with the proposed fire service installations (FSIs) to his Department for approval. In addition, the applicant is advised that the layout plan should be drawn to scale and depicted with dimensions and nature of occupancy and the location of where the proposed FSIs to be installed should be clearly marked on the layout plans. Also, the good practice guidelines for open storage (**Appendix V** of this RNTPC paper) should be adhered to. If the proposed structure(s) is required to comply with the BO, detailed fire service requirements will be formulated upon receipt of formal submission of general building plans; and
- (k) to note the comments of the Director of Water Supplies that for provision of water supply to the development, the applicant may need to extend his/her inside services to the nearest suitable government water mains for connection. The applicant shall resolve any land matter (such as private lots) associated with the provision of water supply and shall be responsible for the construction, operation and maintenance of the inside services within the private lots to Water Supplies Department's standard.
