	Please find below our comments from visual impact perspective for your consideration:	
1.	Para 6.5.1 (M2) – The meaning of the sentence is not clear, it is advised to revise as "A row of new trees will be provided <u>on at</u> the ground floor along the north side, serving as a greenery backdrop <u>when viewed from the podium floor</u> and creating a further green buffer to adjacent lots.	Noted and revised accordingly (Attachment 2 refers).
2.	Para 6.5.2 (M3) – It is suggested revising the paragraph as "Specifically, the proposed development's height strategically falls between the <u>adjacent surrounding</u> higher buildings (Areas 133A, 133B, 133C <u>to the northwest and Areas 129 and 130 to the south and southwest</u>) and the lower buildings to the <u>north (Areas 135 and 141) and</u> east (Areas 136, 137, and 138). This graduated approach directly aligns with the TCE concept of creating a stepped height profile <u>across the development zone</u> that <u>the building height reduced from the mountain backdrop in the south to the waterfront area in the north as stated in the ES of the OZP paragraph 7.1.6."</u>	
3.	Para 6.5.2 (M5) – It is suggested providing the dimension of the setback in this paragraph.	Noted and revised accordingly (<i>Attachment 2</i> refers).
