Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department	29.1.2026	From nature conservation perspective: the applicant should implement measures to protect nearby watercourses from adverse impacts during the construction and operational phases.	<p>The applicant would implement mitigation measures to protect nearby watercourses from adverse impacts during the construction and operational phases.</p> <p>The applicant and contractor will follow good site practice and be responsible for the design construction, operation and maintenance of all the mitigation measures as specified in ProPECC PN 1/94 for construction and site drainage.</p> <p>During construction phase, temporary sand bag barriers would be provided on site to properly direct storm water. The contractor would observe and comply with the WPCO and its subsidiary regulation and carry out the Works in such as manner as to minimise adverse impacts on the water quality during execution of the works.</p> <p>During operation phase, all operation activities would be confined within the application site, sufficient buffer distance from the watercourse would be provided during operation. No non point/diffuse source pollution, such as dust, tyre scraps, etc. would be washed into the watercourses during rainstorms. In addition, runoff would be controlled by best management practice.</p> <p>The applicant is committed to protect nearby watercourses from adverse impacts with the provision and implementation of the mitigation measures.</p>
