I.	Comments	Responses
(1)	The submitted information is insufficient to prove and demonstrate that "Conditions of Working within Gathering Grounds" will be fully complied with to ensure there would be no material increase in pollution effect to the Water Gathering Grounds ('WGG') during the construction phrase. It is noted that the applicant undertakes the installation of bar screen and drainage trap, provision of oil and grease decontamination kit and covered rubbish bin for waste collection on site, no on-site operation/workshop activity, notice posting to prohibit vehicle inspection, maintenance, repairing and washing activities. My specific concerns on the submission are provided as follows from the perspective of water resource protection. - The applicant provides covered rubbish bin on site for waste collection. The applicant should be reminded that all solid waste and sludge arising from the proposed development shall be disposed of properly outside WGG.	Noted. All solid waste and sludge arising from the proposed development will be disposed of properly outside the WGG. It will be regularly collected and transferred to the nearest refuse collection point.
(2)	- The applicant undertakes the installation of drainage traps, but the associated drainage proposal have not been mentioned in the proposed development.	Please see the updated drainage proposal (Plan 5.1a) for details.
(3)	- The acceptance of the drainage proposal and its implementation should be subject to the jurisdiction of the DSD.	Noted.
