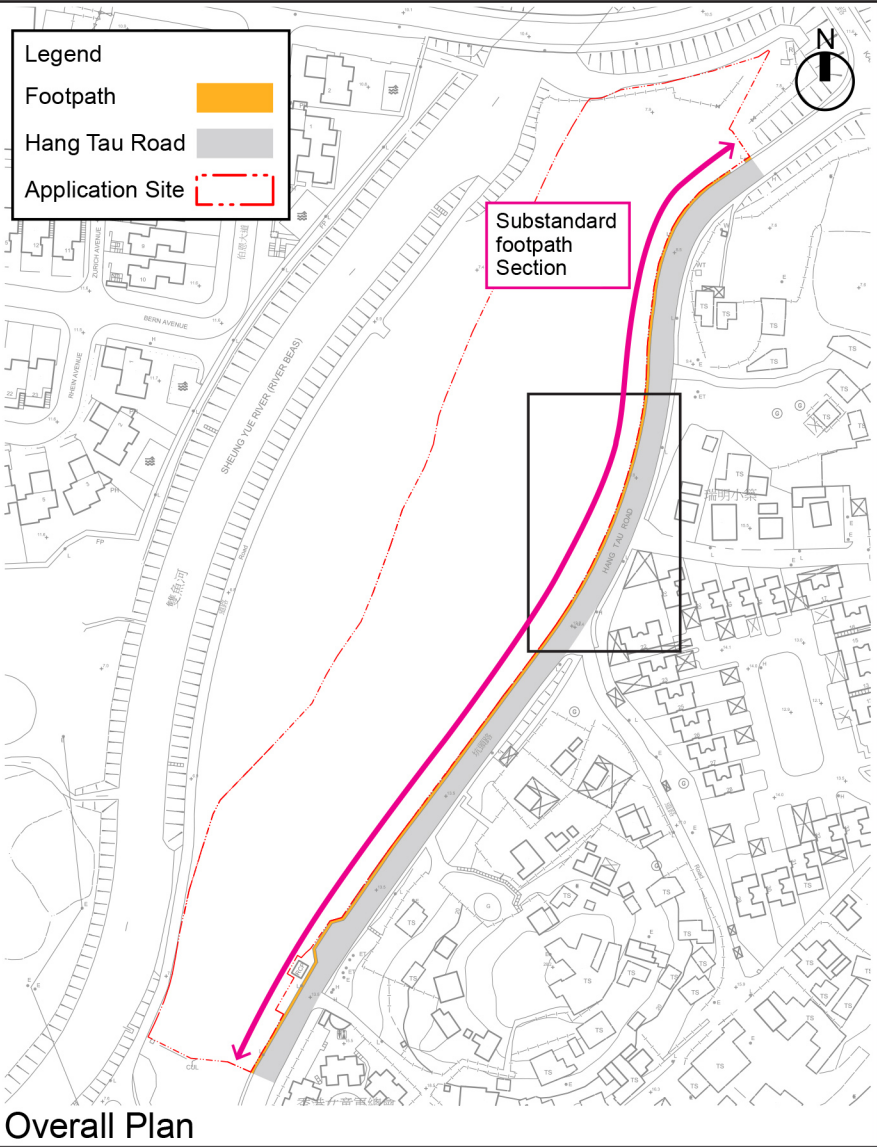

Proposed Hang Tau Road Widening and Footpath**

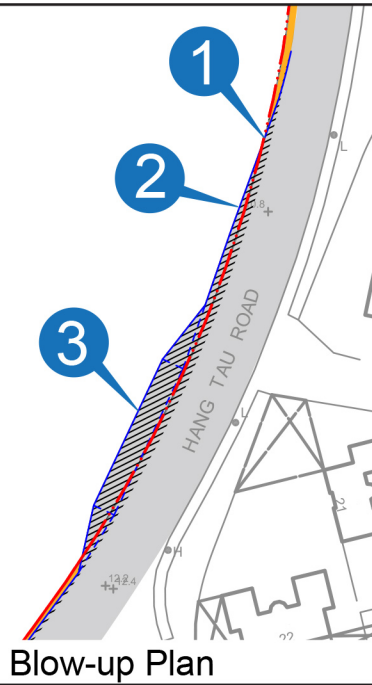
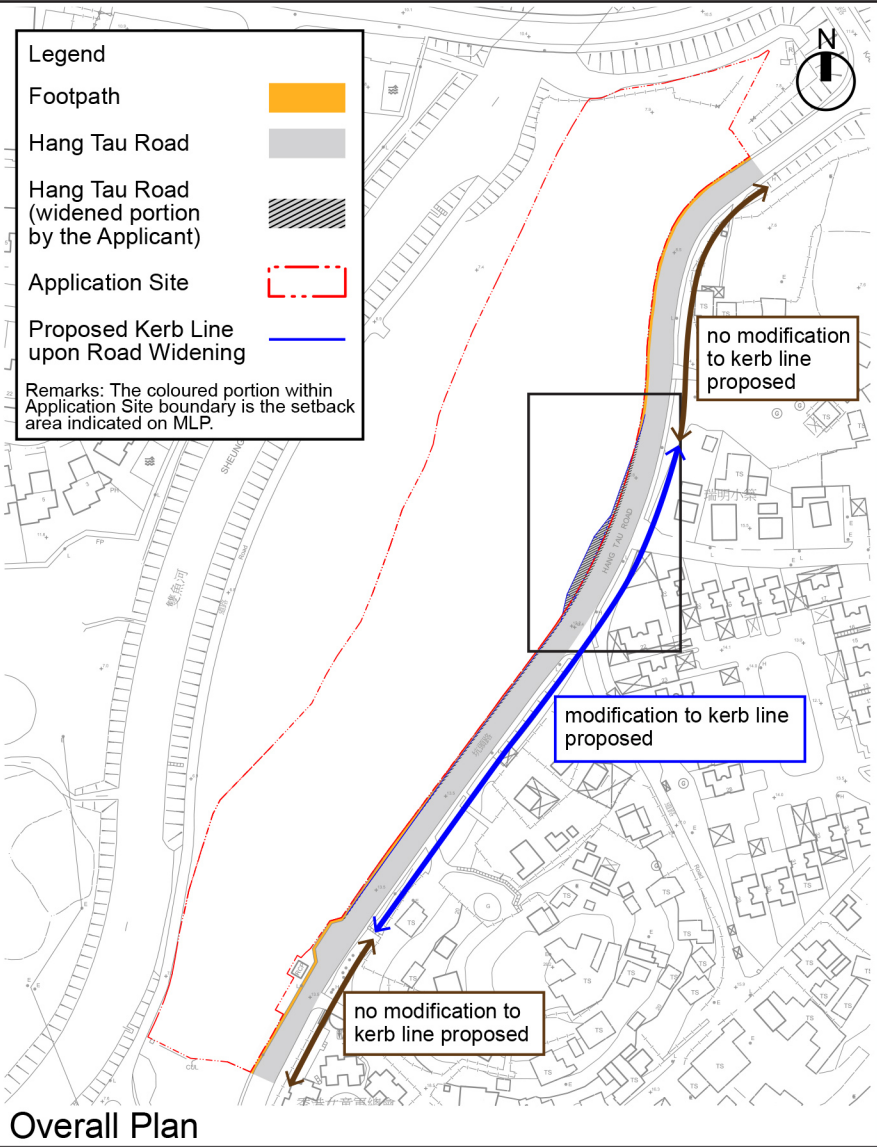
Widening

Existing Condition



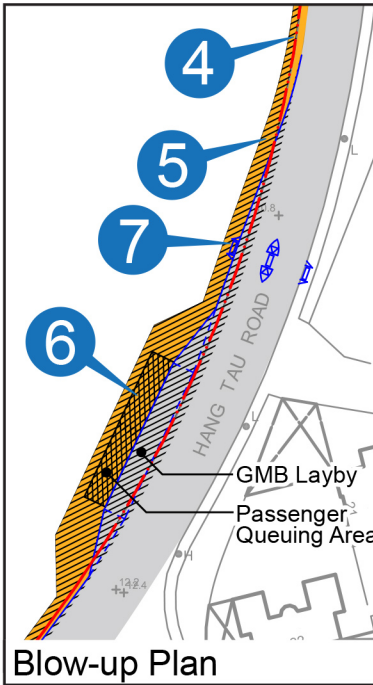
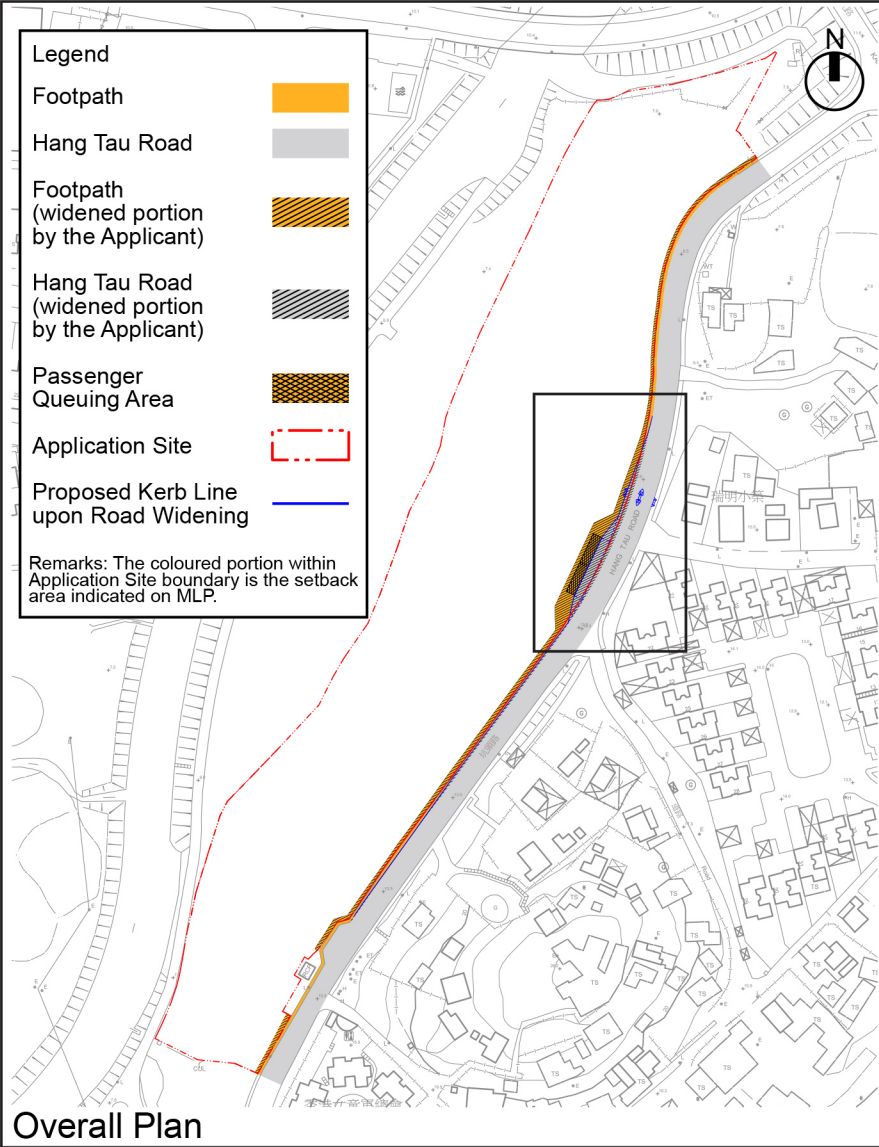
- ◆ Hang Tau Road and its footpath is currently partly substandard. Part of its portion abutting the Application Site is less than 7.3m wide and 2m wide respectively
- ◆ Nil provision of GMB layby and pedestrian crossing facilities at Hang Tau Road for its portion abutting the Application Site
- ◆ The Applicant proposes to upgrade the substandard section

Proposed Hang Tau Road Widening and GMB Layby



- 1 To widen Hang Tau Road to 7.3m wide, a new kerb line is drawn (at the side abutting Application Site)
- 2 Part of the existing footpath and some area within Application Site will become the widened portion of Hang Tau Road with a standard width of 7.3m
- 3 In the middle of the Application Site, the proposed development will further setback to provide a GMB layby at Hang Tau Road

Proposed Footpath Widening and Provision of Pedestrian Crossing Facilities



- 4 For the portion with no change to kerb line, the area abutting the existing footpath will be setback for footpath widening, such that a width of 2m for footpath can be achieved
- 5 Upon proposed widening of Hang Tau Road, further setback within Application Site boundary will be provided such that a continuous footpath of 2m wide can be achieved
- 6 To provide passengers' queuing area for the GMB layby, the portion of pedestrian footpath adjacent to the layby will be wider. The queuing area will be about 70m² (2.9m x 24m)
- 7 To facilitate better accessibility and pedestrian safety, pedestrian crossing facilities will be provided
