We responded to the TD's comments.

1. The application site has been granted planning permission for the construction of a small house, but since the application has not yet received approval from the Lands Department, we wish to temporarily use it as a parking lot.

Additionally, due to the upcoming construction of small houses in the nearby parking area, parking spaces will be reduced, so we hope to use the application site to compensate for the decreased parking availability.

2. We only use Wai Hon Road and pass through the rural road to entering the application site.
3. The dimensions of our vehicles are as follows: Private Cars are approximately 4.5 meters (L) x 1.8 meters (W), Light Goods Vehicle (Van Type) are approximately 4.7 meters (L) x 1.7 meters (W).
4. Please refer to the Access Plan.
5. Please refer to the Proposed Signboard Plan.
6. We will ensure that no vehicle is allowed to queue back to or reverse onto / from public road at any time during the planning approval period.

I refer to the captioned planning application.

2. Please find comments (see below) from Transport Department (TD, Contact Person: Mr. Gary POON, Tel.: [REDACTED]) for your follow up action.

Comments from TD from traffic engineering point of view:

- (i) Although the additional traffic generated by the proposed vehicle park is not significant, the permission of development outside the “V” zone will however set an undesirable precedent case for similar applications in the future. The resulting cumulative adverse traffic impact has to be reviewed on case-by-case basis in the future;
- (ii) Please confirm whether only the local access leading to the development site from Wai Hon Road would be used for entering the site;

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- (iii) The applicant should clarify the dimensions of vehicle used in the swept path analysis;
- (iv) The applicant should advise the locations and dimensions of the passing bays along the access road;
- (v) The applicant should advise the location of the proposed warning sign and ensure that it will not clash with the path of movement of vehicles;
- (vi) No vehicle is allowed to queue back to or reverse onto / from public road at any time during the planning approval period; and
- (vii) The local village access leading to the development site from Yu Tai Road and Wai Hon Road are not managed by this Department. The applicant should clarify with relevant land owners and maintenance authorities on the management and maintenance responsibilities of the local village access accordingly.

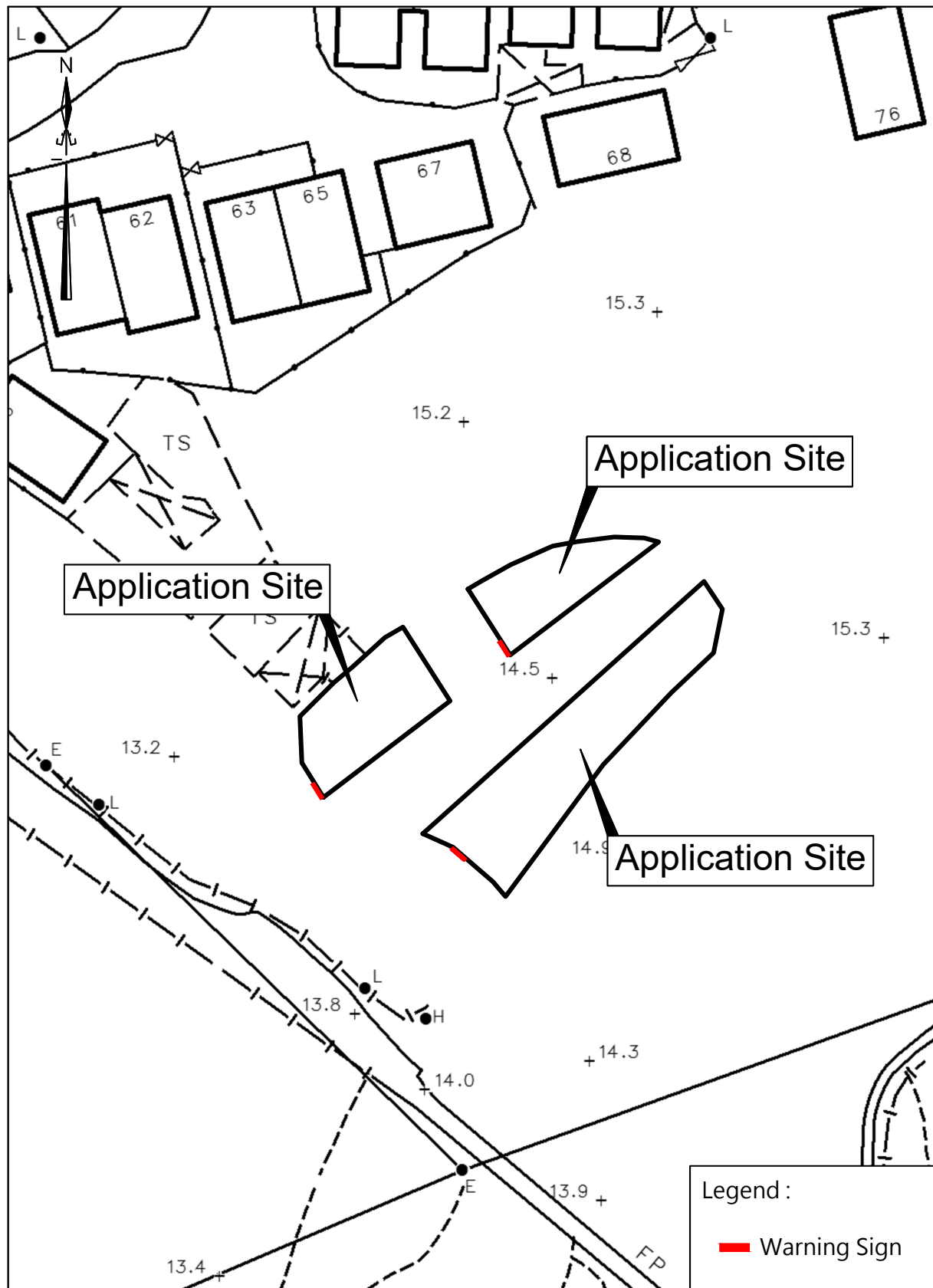
