- 2) Reply to Environmental Protection Mr. Alan : An automated water level monitoring device will be installed to detect real-time changes in the pool's water level. When the water level exceeds the standard limit, a pump will divert the excess water to a backup storage tank, which will later be removed by water trucks. Additionally, large water storage tanks will be set up on-site as a buffer reserve. The number of tanks can be flexibly adjusted based on seasonal rainfall. The stored water will be recycled for purposes such as landscape irrigation and environmental cleaning within the premises.
