### **Confirmation and Declaration (provided by Albert Lau)**

The undersigned confirms that all information provided in this letter is true, accurate and complete. The land use, agricultural facilities and electricity demand comply with the requirements for agricultural land use. We undertake to fully cooperate with the AFCD and Planning Department in the review process and provide any further documentation as required.

We also confirm that the site will be used strictly for agricultural farming purposes, without unauthorised change of use, unauthorised structures or any public commercial activities.

### **Response to Comments from AFCD (provided by Albert Lau)**

- a) Details of Agricultural Electricity Usage

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The site is strictly for agricultural farming purposes only and will not be open to the public. All electricity supply is for agricultural operations and daily farm management, as detailed below:

a) Lighting

The farm is located on a hillside with no existing lighting. When farming work continues until dusk or at night, the area is completely dark, creating a high risk of work accidents. Stable electricity for lighting is essential for on-site work safety.

b) Irrigation

The farmland is situated on high ground, while the water source is from a stream at a lower level. Electricity is required to power water pumps to lift water from the stream to the farmland for distribution across different zones, ensuring the survival and healthy growth of crops.

c) Weeding

Trees and weeds inside and around the farm are dense and fast-growing. To protect the environment and avoid using herbicides that damage soil quality, electric machinery is needed for regular trimming and weeding. Therefore, a reliable power supply for such equipment is essential.

d) Water Heater

During hot weather, farmers and on-site staff need safe drinking water. Without electricity, boiled water is unavailable. Drinking untreated stream or rainwater may introduce bacteria and cause health hazards. Electricity for a water heater is necessary to ensure safe drinking water.

e) CCTV

As part of agricultural support facilities, the CCTV system requires continuous and stable electricity for site security and property protection.

b) Agricultural Structures and On-site Facilities

1. there are no permanent agricultural structures on site. Only containers are used as temporary supporting facilities for agricultural production, for storage of crops, farming tools and materials, without any unauthorised structures.

2. The site is not participating in the Organic Farming Support Service Scheme, Voluntary Registration Scheme, Accredited Farm Scheme, or "Agri enJoy" Scheme. The land is used exclusively for agricultural farming with no other commercial or educational uses.

**Response to Queries from Planning Department (provided by Albert Lau)**

a) Land Use of Lot 482

Its core use is agricultural farming, with no public visits, experience activities, educational programmes or other commercial operations.

b) On-site Farming and Facilities

1. The lot is designated for agricultural cultivation, used solely for crop planting and related farming activities.

2. Only agricultural supporting facilities are provided, including containers, irrigation equipment, electric weeding tools and CCTV. No residential, commercial or educational buildings are proposed.

c) whether the Lot will be open to public

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The lot is not open to the public.

A portion of the application site falls within Government Land Licence No. S10103 for the purpose of unimproved grazing and grass cutting and the growing of pine trees on a non-commercial basis. The applicant is required to consult the licensee concerned prior to the commencement of the works;

A portion of the application site also falls within water gathering grounds. Water Supplies Department should be consulted prior to the commencement of the works;

The application site is in the vicinity of the boundaries of Slope No. 8SW-A/CR303(1) and Simplified Temporary Land Allocation No. STLA-TSK 400 which has been allocated to Slope Maintenance Section, Lands Department. The applicant is required to consult Slope Maintenance Section, Lands Department prior to the commencement of the works.

**Electricity Safety**

In the interests of public safety and ensuring the continuity of electricity supply, the parties concerned with planning, designing, organizing and supervising any activity near the underground cable or overhead line under the mentioned document should approach the electricity supplier for the requisition of cable plans and overhead line alignment drawings, where applicable, to find out whether there is any underground cable and/or overhead line within and/or in the vicinity of the concerned site. 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### **Town Gas Safety**
