

## Section 16 Application for Proposed Meter Box for Agricultural Use at Lot 577 in D.D. 316, Pui O, Lantau Island, New Territories

I refer to your application under s.16 of the Town Planning Ordinance submitted to the Town Planning Board (TPB) on 9.8.2023 for the captioned use at the captioned site (the site). Supplementary information was subsequently received on 19.8.2023, 21.8.2023 and 24.8.2023.

The site falls within an area zoned "Coastal Protection Area" ("CPA") on the approved South Lantau Coast Outline Zoning Plan (OZP) No. S/SLC/21. According to the application form and supplementary information submitted, a meter box (dimensions: 0.65m x 0.3m x 0.8m) for power supply from CLP Power Hong Kong Limited to support the pumping and irrigation system and machineries for growing crops is proposed. You have also confirmed that there will be no filling of land or excavation of land. According to the Notes of the OZP, 'Agricultural Use (other than Plant Nursery)' is a column 1 use which is always permitted in the "CPA" zone. The Covering Notes of the OZP also state that all uses directly related and ancillary to the permitted uses and developments within the same zone are always permitted and no separate permission is required. As such, planning permission from the TPB is not required for the proposed meter box to support agricultural use.

Please also note that any use or development which is always permitted or may be permitted in accordance with the Notes of the OZP must also conform to any other relevant legislations, the conditions of the Government lease concerned, and any other government requirements, as may be applicable. You are also reminded to seek confirmation from CLP Power Hong Kong Limited to ensure the design of the proposed meter box is acceptable. Should there be any change to the proposal that involve filling/excavation of land and diversion of streams to effect the construction and installation of the proposed meter box, planning permission from the TPB will be required.
