	<p>Please be informed that the application site is situated within the Ngau Hom Shek Site of Archaeological Interest. It is noted from the planning statement that (1) drainage facilities will be provided at the site and (2) land filling works will be undertaken to regularize the site. Thus, for the part of the drainage facilities, the applicant is required to confirm/clarify with the Antiquities and Monuments Office (AMO) whether there is any ground excavation proposed for the development including but not limited to site formation works, drainage works, sewerage works, construction of septic tank etc. If affirmative, the applicant is required to provide details of the proposed works, e.g. the location, extent and depth of the proposed ground excavation for AMO's comment. In addition, please also provide the thickness of soil laid in land filling works to the site for AMO's comments too.</p>	<p>Please note that drainage facilities in majority of the site areas have been constructed under previous Planning Application No. A/YL-HTF/1128 approved on 18.2.2022. There would be only limited additional drainage facilities (i.e. the water drains with a depth of up to approximately 600mm) to be provided at a small portion of the application site, mainly along the application site boundary subject to the Drainage Services Department's requirements.</p> <p>Except the additional drainage works along the site boundary, no extra excavation works would be carried out on site.</p> <p>Please also note that the site has already been paved with less than 0.2m thick concrete materials for many years. It is not necessary to carry out additional land filling works on the site under this planning application.</p> <p>Due to no new land filling works and limited drainage works, adverse impact on archaeological interest is not anticipated.</p>
