Annex 1 Traffic Generation and Attraction

- The application site is serviced by an existing vehicular track leading from Deep 1.1 Bay Road. Such vehicular track mainly falls upon private land.
- The estimated average traffic generation and traffic generation rate at peak hours 1.2 below.
- The operation hour of the application site is 9:00a.m. to 7:00p.m. on all days. The 1.3 proposed development is intended to serve a maximum of 10 persons at the same time. In the reason that the site is only 8 minutes walk from Deep Bay Road which is served by public mini green-bus, it is trust that 2 parking spaces as proposed by the applicant would cater for the demand.
- In association with the intended purpose, adequate space for manoeuvring of 1.4 vehicle would be provided within the application site and queueing up of traffic would not be the result especially that the traffic generated is insignificant. The negligible increase in traffic would not aggravate the traffic condition of Deep Bay Road and nearby road networks.
