Geotechnical Comment for A/YL-LFS/587	Responses
<p>There are two registered man-made features (i.e. Features Nos. 2SW-C/C111 and 2SW-C/C117) with a maximum height of 6m located within the application site, which may affect or be affected by the proposed development. Therefore the applicant is required to submit a Geotechnical Planning Review Report (GPRR) with their planning application in accordance with the Guidance Notes for Application for Permission under Section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance (CAP. 131).</p>	<p>The subject site is subject to a previously approved planning application No. A/YL-LFS/457, under which no GPRR was required. Similar to the previously approved application, the Site is predominantly occupied by two major existing structures for warehouse use (Structures Nos. 1 and 3), and the conditions of the existing structures (Nos. 1 to 6) remain unchanged.</p> <p>In addition to the existing structures, the current application proposes six single-storey structures (Nos. 7 to 13) for site office, guard room, store room, and water tank and pump room uses. The majority of these proposed minor structures (Nos. 8 to 13) are located at least 30m and 70m away from the man-made features Nos. 2SW-C/C117 and 2SW-C/C111 respectively. The remaining proposed structure, No. 7, adjoins the existing structure No. 6 and is also located at least 30m and 45m away from the man-made features Nos. 2SW-C/C117 and 2SW-C/C111 respectively. As such, the proposed structures have no impact to the man-made features Nos. 2SW-C/C117 and 2SW-C/C111.</p> <p>As there is no major change in planning circumstances and the existing conditions of the Site remain unchanged, it is considered that the current application would not have any impact on geotechnical aspect and therefore a GPRR is not required.</p>
