Section 16 Planning Application for Proposed Temporary Recyclable Collection Centre (Construction Materials) with Ancillary Facilities and Associated Filling of Land for a Period of 3 Years at Lot Nos. 1594, 1595, 1596, 1597, 1598 S.A, 1598 RP, 1599, 1600, 1609, 1610, 1611, 1612, 1613 (Part) in D.D. 118 and adjoining Government Land, Tai Tong, Yuen Long

We refer to our captioned submission and would like to submit clarifications to facilitate considerations by relevant departments and the Town Planning Board.

It is clarified that the proposed workshop and general storage uses will provide designated indoor areas for sorting, compressing and packing activities as well as storage of necessary machinery and equipment. No material breaking, burning, melting, washing or cleaning of recycling materials activities will be involved in the proposed operations. Recyclable materials will be sorted, compressed and packed at the application site prior to being shipped to the Mainland for further processing. All workshop activities and compressors will be contained indoor within the enclosed structures at all times.

In addition, it is clarified that the application site will be filled with concrete or recycling materials (i.e. crumb rubber asphalt).
