TOWN PLANNING ORDINANCE (Chapter 131) APPLICATION FOR PLANNING PERMISSION

In accordance with section 16(2I) of the Ordinance, any comment made to the Board will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at locations (i) and (ii) above until the Board has considered the application in question under section 16(3).

The gists of the applications (including location plans) can be viewed at the above locations, the Secretariat of the Board and the Board's website.

The tentative date of the Board meeting to consider the application has been uploaded to the Board's website. The meeting for considering planning applications, except the deliberation parts, will be open to the public. Seats will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.
