**Representation in Support of Amendment Item A1 of Draft Tuen Mun Outline Zoning
Plan No. S/TM/42 – Lingnan University Campus Expansion Plan**

The Office of Campus Development and Management at Lingnan University fully supports the proposed amendment item A1 to the Draft Tuen Mun Outline Zoning Plan No. S/TM/42 regarding our Campus Expansion Plan.

In line with national policies and government initiatives to build Hong Kong into an international education hub, Lingnan University continues to expand its academic and research programs. Beyond our strong foundation in the arts and humanities, we are actively developing programs in data science, artificial intelligence, and interdisciplinary fields, while supporting the "Study in Hong Kong" brand.

Lingnan University has achieved excellent results in the latest global rankings, reflecting its sustained institutional progress. In the Times Higher Education (THE) Sustainability Impact Rankings 2026, the University entered the global top 100, ranking 63rd. It also ranked 84th in the THE Asia University Rankings and climbed more than 120 places to 581st in the QS World University Rankings 2027.

Student enrolment has grown significantly in recent years. As Director of Campus Development and Management, it is observed that existing campus space can no longer meet the demand generated by this increase. To sustain this momentum and accommodate rising student numbers, additional campus space and facilities are significantly required. The proposed expansion is essential for the following reasons:-

1. Relieving Spatial Constraints: Existing teaching rooms, laboratories, and study areas are running at full capacity. Additional floor space is urgently needed for academic and research activities.
2. Optimizing Existing Land: Developing within our current site boundary makes the best use of developed land. Our proposed expansion plan does not involve any existing green belt area.
3. Supporting District Growth: Bringing more students and researchers will add vitality to the Tuen Mun community and foster closer educational synergy with the Northern Metropolis.

This expansion is critical to resolving our space shortages and sustaining Lingnan University's educational mission. We urge the Town Planning Board to approve Proposed Amendment Item A1 under Draft OZP No. S/TM/42.

**Representation in support of Amendment Item A1 of the
Draft Tuen Mun Outline Zoning Plan No. S/TM/42**

The Tuen Mun campus of Lingnan University (LU) was established in 1995, initially serving fewer than 1,000 students. Over the past three decades, the student population has grown significantly. However, the current height restrictions as stipulated in the Outline Zoning Plan (OZP) have constrained the University's ability to develop and expand its facilities to meet this growth.

The proposed relaxation of these height restrictions is both urgent and necessary. Thoughtful campus development, incorporating buildings of varying building heights will foster a more dynamic and conducive learning environment while respecting the architectural integrity of the existing core structures (i.e. Wing On Plaza and the nearby LU Main Building which are of historical significance, reflecting Lingnan architectural style). This approach will preserve the University's tradition and identity while accommodating future needs.

Various technical assessments were also conducted to ascertain that the proposal will not give rise to insurmountable adverse impacts. Opportunity is also taken to enhance the pedestrian connectivity through the proposed footbridge extension with the existing footbridge network.

Amending the Tuen Mun OZP is essential to support the increasing student population and aligns with the Government's "Study in Hong Kong" initiative, which aims to enhance Hong Kong's reputation as an international academic hub. In light of the general support obtained from previous consultations and engagements with the Tuen Mun District Council, Tuen Mun Rural Committee, Rural and New Town Planning Committee, and LU's exhibition, I therefore express my strong support for the Draft Tuen Mun Outline Zoning Plan No. S/TM/42.

AMENDMENTS TO TUEN MUN OZP NO. S/TM/41

Dear TPB Members,

Item A1 – about 11.44 ha. Revision to BHR for “GIC” zones of two sites currently occupied by the Main Campus and Multi Purpose Outdoor Sports Ground of the Li’ngnan University in Area 52. Increase from 1/4/10 storeys to 120mPD.

HK has embarked on a programme of expanding all our universities without any consideration being taken as to whether the current model is appropriate for an A1 driven future. The layout is essentially more of the same old same old combination of class rooms, recreational facilities and dorms.

Like Work from Home, universities as a whole will not require a mandatory physical presence in the future. Instead, higher education is permanently shifting toward a hybrid, "always-on" model where physical attendance is an optional feature but the HK model is based on the existing format that may no longer be popular in coming years.

That students live or congregate on campus is desirable from the perspective of their social growth and integration, but this may not be compatible with a tech driven society. The commercial rewards of attracting more students to the territory has not taken into consideration the fast-evolving changes in society.

Main Campus currently 25mPD to 66mPD

“The Indoor Sports Complex, swimming pool, Lau Chung Him Building, President’s Lodge and its adjoining hill knolls would be redeveloped into six new research/academic buildings with BHs ranging from about 52.4mPD to 119.7mPD (or 8 to 22 storeys).”

Sports Ground 23mPD

“The existing multipurpose outdoor sports ground and Wofoo Joseph Lee Student Activity Centre would be redeveloped into three academic/amenities/living quarters buildings providing about 4,000 bed spaces for student accommodation with BHs of about 43.8mPD to 116.3mPD (or 7 to 26 storeys) centered around a two-storey (or about 30.8mPD) new sports complex, a sports ground sitting atop an indoor swimming pool and a sports centre.”

While a significant increase in students is proposed, *“LU estimates that its total student enrolment would be increased from about 8,000 at present to about 10,000 by 2028/2029 and the total enrolment is anticipated to reach almost 20,000 in 2038/39”*, there is an equally significant decrease in the provision of both sports facilities and open space.

The Main Campus would effectively lose all its sports facilities and around 50% of its OS. Moreover, the remaining OS near the Main Building would be surrounded by significant wall effect.

The proposed Sports Centre has a reduced footprint and will also be boxed in by wall effect. This is contrary to the pledges to expand sports and other facilities to promote student wellness and sports excellence. Outdoor facilities boost physical health, relieve stress, and build mental resilience. Running, cycling, and team sports strengthen the heart and improve blood circulation. Outdoor training helps the body make vitamin D, which builds strong bones and boosts immunity and fresh air and physical exertion help students fall asleep faster and rest more.

There is no comparison provided on the current GFA of Sports facilities and Open Space per head and the ratio under the proposed plans. The planned increase in student numbers is 2.5% but the provision of both facilities will be decreased not increased. This is certainly not satisfactory.

The Visual Impact is extensive, Many of the current views of the ridge lines will be wiped out. Viewpoint 4 is particularly problematic. Members should take into consideration that if the plan is approved it will be followed over the years by Sec 16 applications to relax the BHR. Protecting ridgeline views is essential to preserve a city's natural landscape, maintain visual connections with nature, and safeguard unique skylines and landmarks.

Members should push for regulations for NT similar to those that protect HKI and Kowloon ridgelines before any more landmark views that are anchors for society are obliterated.

Item A2 – about 0.04 ha . Rezoning of a strip of land being part of the Main Campus of the Lingnan University from “Res (Group B) 16” to **“G/IC”** with BHR 120mPD.

Incorporating a strip of land (about 0.09 ha) along Beneville into Main Campus

Item A3 – about 0.04 ha. Rezoning of a strip of land being part of a residential development to the north of the Main Campus of the Lingnan University from “G/IC” to “R(B)16” with BHR 106mPD..

Part of Beneville development.

Item A4 – about 0.02 ha. Rezoning of a strip of land to the northwest of the MPOSG of the Lingnan University from “Res (Group C)” to **“G/IC”** with BHR 120mPD.

Incorporating into North Campus.

A2 – A4 MUSICAL CHAIRS

Item A5 – about 0.04 ha. Revision to the BHR for a strip of land to the east of Lam Tei Raw Water Pumping Station Staff Quarters in the “G/IC” zone.

Increase BHR from 1 to 2 storeys.

Item A6 – about 0.04 ha. Revision to the BHR for a site to the north of Fu Tei Road in the “G/IC” zone.

Adjustment to rationalise the related BHR to reflect the existing BH of 10 storeys for the whole RCHE site. Completed in 2020.

A5 – A6 HOUSEKEEPING

Item B1 – about 0.18ha. Rezoning of a strip of land to the east of Tuen Mun River Channel in Area 16 from “Open Space” to “G/IC”.

To incorporate into ‘GIC’ zone planned as 3-storey Proposed Sports Ground with Open Space and PVP.

Item B2 – about 5.6ha. Deletion of the BHR for the southern portion of “G/IC” zone to the west of Hoi Wong Road in Area 16.

STRONG OBJECTIONS. BHR IS CURRENTLY 3-STOREYS. DELETING THE BHR WOULD ALLOW A MULTI-STOREY DEVELOPMENT. SPORTS FACILITIES SHOULD BE DESIGNED LIKE KAI TAK, LOW RISE AND WITH PENETRATION OF NATURAL LIGHT TO THE FACILITIES.

THE INTENTION IS OBVIOUSLY TO USE THE SITE FOR A DEVELOPMENT LIKE THAT AT THE URA FLOWER MARKET DEVELOPMENT WHEREBY ALL AT GRADE FACILITIES ARE EXCISED AND THE SPORTS FACILITIES ARE PROVIDED ON THE PODIUM OF HIGH-RISE RESIDENTIAL TOWERS. THE HONEST PROCESS WOULD BE TO USE THE OZP TO REZONE TO THE TRUE INTENTION.

MOREOVER WHY REDEVELOP VICTORIA PARK TENNIS COURT DEPRIVING THE COMMUNITY OF FACILITIES FOR A NUMBER OF YEARS AND NO DOUBT REQUIRING FURTHER INCURSION INTO THAT PARK AND MORE FELLING OF TREES.

NEW SPORTS FACILITIES SHOULD BE CONSTRUCTED IN NT WHERE THERE IS A DEARTH OF FACILITIES OF AN INTERNATIONAL STANDARD DESPITE PLANS TO GREATLY INCREASE THE POPULATION. WHY ARE SPORTS GROUNDS STILL BEING PLANNED FOR HKI AND KOWLOON WHEN THEY SHOULD BE UP NORTH?
