PLANNING STATEMENT

Executive Summary:

We seek planning permission under section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance (Cap. 131) from the Town Planning Board (the "**Board**") to use the application site, namely Remaining Portion of Lot No. 1236 and Section C of Lot No. 1237 in Demarcation District No. 117 (the "**Site**"), for proposed religious institution (Christian worshipping centre).

According to the Approved Tai Tong Outline Zoning Plan No. S/YL-TT/20, "Religious Institution (not elsewhere specified)" is a Column 2 use within the "AGR" zone which requires planning permission.

We propose to erect a building with not more than 3 storeys, height of not more than 9m and gross floor area of not more than 812m² on the Site for Christian worshipping and related activities.

We are a Christian organisation in Hong Kong and a charitable institution registered under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance (Cap 112) since 2004.

The Site has been used for Christian worshipping and related activities, and we have been maintaining good relationship with the local community.

We fully realise the need of our society to build up and sustain a mutually caring and righteous culture, especially among the young generation. We also understand the importance of having a safe place with a healthy environment where teenagers and children in the local community can gather and learn about caring of people, love, respect and righteousness as well as the commandments of God, and become a good citizen. This will help to promote positive life attitude and spiritual development of the youths and children in our society.

The Proposed Development would enable us to:

- (a) promote Christian faith;
- (b) teach people Jesus' commandments on caring of people, love, respect and righteousness; and
- (c) provide a healthy environment for members for their personal growth mentioned in (b) above.

1. The Proposal

- 1.1. We would like to seek planning permission to use the application site (the "Site") for proposed religious institution (Christian worshipping centre). According to the Notes of the OZP, "Religious Institution (not elsewhere specified)" is a Column 2 use within the "AGR" zone which requires planning permission from the Town Planning Board (the "Board").
- 1.2. The Site is subject to a previous application for permission (s16) (Case number: A/DPA/YL-TT5). The use applied for was "Residential Development" and the planning permission was initially approved in June 1994 but expired in June 1996. For further details, please refer paragraph 6.1 below. This current S.16 application is not connected to the aforementioned application.

Current use of the Site and existing structure

- 1.3. The Site is hard paved and partly currently occupied by a temporary structure (the "Temporary Structure").
- 1.4. For over 20 years, the Site has not been used for agricultural or farming purpose.
- 1.5. For the avoidance of doubt, the 3-storey small house situated on Section C of Lot No. 1236 in D.D. 117 is not part of the Site and not subject to the current S16 application. The said small house was erected in accordance with Building Licence No.707 (dated 25 June 1975, as modified and rectified) and was certified to have complied with the conditions of the license on 14 April 1981.

1.6. The parameters of Temporary Structure are shown in the table below:

- 1.7. The floor plans and elevation of the Temporary Structure are as set out in **Attachment 1**.
- 1.8. The Temporary Structure is currently used for Christian worshipping and related activities (the "Existing Use").

Proposed Development

1.9. We now propose to erect a 3-storey building with a building height of not more than 9m (main roof) and gross floor area of not more than 812m² (excluding floor area of the rooftop) on the Site (the "Proposed Building"), where the Temporary Structure is erected. Detailed development parameters are shown in the table below:

- 1.10. The floor plans, elevation and access plan are as set out in **Attachment 2**.
- 1.11. The Proposed Building will be mainly used for Christian worshipping and related activities (the "**Proposed Use**"), which is same as the Existing Use of the Temporary Structure.
- 1.12. The ground floor of the Proposed Building will consist of a chapel, with gross floor area of not more than 330m². The first floor will consist of a multi-function room with gross floor area of not more than 152m². The second floor will consist of a multi-function room with gross floor area of not more than 330m². Greening and plantation will be provided on the rooftop.
- 1.13. An area of not less than 120m² on the façade of the Proposed Building will be used for planting, and not less than 300m² on the rooftop (approximately 91% of the rooftop area), will be used for planting, farming and agricultural purpose (e.g. fruit tree, vegetable, flowers and herbs).
- 1.14. Overnight accommodation at the Proposed Building is not envisaged.

- 1.15. There will be no activities related to catering services, funeral services, burning of joss paper/offerings, columbarium services and worshipping of ancestor tablets within the Site or the Proposed Building.
- 1.16. Subject to viability, community services will be provided to the local residents.
- 1.17. Same as the Temporary Structure, the Proposed Building is designed to accommodate a maximum of 100 Christian worshippers.
- 1.18. It is currently expected that there will be one worship session every Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday. Generally, each session will normally be participated by 50 Christian worshippers.
- 1.19. The proposed operation hours of the Site are between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m. daily.
- 1.20. Each worship session at the Site will be mainly carried out indoor. With the provision of double-glazed windows and air-conditioning, minimal nuisance will be caused to the neighbourhood.
- 1.21. As the Site is well-developed already, filling of land, alteration of existing building, excavation, diversion of stream, site formation or tree felling are not envisaged for the Proposed Development.

(The above is collectively referred to as the "Proposed Development")

Traffic

- 1.22. The Site is right next to Tai Tong Road and is easily accessible by vehicle, minibus, K66 bus route operated by MTR and on foot. Currently, majority of the visitors access the Site by means of public transportation.
- 1.23. Currently, the Site is accommodating 4 parking spaces. For the Proposed Development, not more than 4 car parking spaces will be provided within the Site.
- 1.24. It is worth noting that for at least the past 10 years, operation of the Site has minimal impact on traffic and surrounding road network (including the Tai Tong Road). In the future, most visitors are expected to access the Site as in the past, i.e. by means of public transportation and on foot. The current application is only for regularizing the Existing Use of the Site, and hence it is not expected to have additional impact on the traffic.
- 1.25. No loading/unloading space will be provided within the Site.
- 1.26. Given that the Site level is lower than the Tai Tong Road and the footpath, surface water running is not expected to run from the Site and have impact to Tai Tong Road or footpath. Nonetheless, proper measures will be carried out to prevent surface water running from the Site to the nearby public roads and drains.
- 1.27. Taking into account the small scale of the Proposed Building and nearby developed public transport system, and that the Site has been used for the Proposed Use for over 20 years already, adverse impact on the traffic and infrastructure nearby is not anticipated.

Drainage and Sewerage

- 1.28. As the Site is already well-developed, the Proposed Development does not anticipate any additional drainage and surface-runoff and increment of existing catchment.
- 1.29. The Proposed Development does not anticipate the requirement of any additional septic tank and soakaway pit system.

Environment

- 1.30. The Proposed Development is expected to have no adverse impact to the environment.
- 1.31. To further minimise the potential noise impact, the Christian worshipping and related activities will be carried out indoors, with the provision of double-glazed windows and air-conditioning.
- 1.32. No public announcement system, portable loudspeakers or any form of audio amplification system will be installed outdoors. Hence adverse environmental impact is not anticipated.
- 1.33. We will comply with the Code of Practice on Handling the Environmental Aspects of Temporary Uses and Open Storage Sites (處理臨時用途及露天貯存用地環境問題作業指引).
- 1.34. The Site is currently hard paved and has not been used for any agricultural activities for over 20 years. At present, it possesses limited potential for agricultural rehabilitation.
- 1.35. In view of its small area, the Site is not economically or commercially viable for commercial farming.
- 1.36. The Proposed Development will actually help to promote greenery and agriculture activities at the Site. In the current proposal, an area of not less than 120 m² on the façade of the Proposed Building will be used for greening and plantation, and not less than 300 m² on the rooftop (approximately 91% of the rooftop floor area), will be used for greening, plantation and agricultural purposes (e.g. fruit tree, vegetable, flowers and herbs). As voluntary work, church members will be encouraged to cultivate and take proper care of these areas. This arrangement will have a positive effect to the surrounding environment and should be supported from an agricultural perspective.
- 1.37. Peripheral planting will be provided at the Site to enhance the amenity of the area. Measures to avoid causing disturbance or pollution to the surrounding wooded area will also be adopted.
- 1.38. The Proposed Development is in fact in line with the planning intentions of the "AGR" zone according to the OZP, i.e. to retain and safeguard good quality agricultural land/farm/fish ponds for agricultural purposes.

Landscape and Visual

1.39. The Site is already well-developed and currently hard paved with shrub planting. There are no existing mature trees at the Site. Significant adverse landscape impact on landscape and landscape resources arising from the Proposed Development is not anticipated.

- 1.40. As could be seen from Attachment 1, the Temporary Structure is a structure with external tin-sheet cladding, and is relatively less aesthetically pleasing. The Proposed Development will replace the "tin-sheeted house" with the Proposed Building, which is a permanent and a well architecture designed 3-storey building.
- 1.41. Soft landscaped planters and greenery are proposed to be planted on the Proposed Building's façade and on the rooftop. This will undoubtedly help enhance the overall landscape quality.
- 1.42. Given (i) the low-rise nature of the Proposed Building; (ii) height of the existing surrounding buildings and structures; and (iii) the Site is approximately one level lower than the Tai Tong Road, minimal adverse visual impact is anticipated for the Proposed Development.

2. The Surrounding Areas of the Site

- 2.1. The surrounding areas of the Site are rural in character predominated by scattered residential structures/dwellings, open storage, warehouse, parking of vehicles, vacant land, plant nursery, vegetated hillslopes, and agricultural land.
- 2.2. Immediately to the East of the Site is an easement, and a piece of vacant land. And at a further distance, two residential dwellings. Please refer to **Attachment** 3.
- 2.3. Immediately, to the South of the Site is a small CLP substation and Tai Tong Road. Across the road is a car repair garage and some vacant lands. Please refer to **Attachment 3**.
- 2.4. To the West of the Site is Choi Chee Ming Luen Kwong Scout Centre (蔡志明聯 光童軍中心) (the "Scout Centre"). The zoning of the lot is "Government, Institution or Community" (G/IC) pursuant to the OZP. According to its website, the Scout Centre has 1 hall, 2 lecture rooms, 2 leader rooms, 1 conference room, 3 camping grounds, 1 basketball court and 1 camp-fire circle. Different types of recreation activity and training are being carried out at the Scout Centre from time to time. From time to time, scouts would stay overnight at the Scout Camp. Please refer to Attachment 3.
- 2.5. Immediately to the North of the Site, is a 3-storey small house owned by us, with height of approximately 9m (main roof). Further North is a drainage channel, and followed by a 2-storey residential dwelling. Please refer to **Attachment 3**.
- 2.6. The Proposed Building would have similar size (with slight increment) as the Temporary Structure .
- 2.7. On visual perspective, the Proposed Development is not incompatible with the surrounding visual context and is unlikely to induce significant adverse visual impact to the surrounding areas. The Proposed Building will be harmonious with the adjacent building developments which are of 2 to 3-storey in building height.
- 2.8. Further, the Proposed Development is compatible with the adjacent Scout Centre, which is used as a place for recreation activities and training for scouts.
- 2.9. The Site is not part of or within any village, and hence the Proposed Development would have minimal disturbs to the local community.

- 2.10. The Proposed Development is compatible with the planning intention of "AGR" zone as "Religious Institution (not elsewhere specified)" is Column 2 use which can be approved by the Board upon application.
- 2.11. Given the above, the Proposed Development is compatible with the surrounding environment.

3. Justifications for the Proposed Development

Benefit to the Society and local community

- 3.1. We are a Christian organisation in Hong Kong and a charitable institution registered under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance (Cap 112) since 2004. Please refer to **Attachments 4 and 5**, for the supporting documents.
- 3.2. We currently have around 60 regular members in Hong Kong, including children, youth and adults.
 - The Site has been used for Christian worshipping and related activities and we have been maintaining good relationship with the local community.
- 3.3. We fully realise the need of our society to build up and sustain a mutually caring and righteous culture, especially among the young generation. We also understand the importance of having a safe place with a healthy environment where teenagers and children in the local community can gather and learn about caring of people, love, respect and righteousness as well as the commandments of God, and become a good citizen. This will help to promote positive life attitude and spiritual development of the youths and children in our society.
- 3.4. The Proposed Development would enable us to:
 - (a) promote Christian faith;
 - (b) teach them Jesus' commandments on caring of people, love, respect and righteousness; and
 - (c) provide a healthy environment for members for their personal growth mentioned in (b) above.

Compatibility

3.5. The Site is located at a convenient location suitable for church development. Apart from its compatibility with the existing surrounding context both in terms of building height and volume, the design of the Proposed Building will integrate well with the buildings/structures nearby and surrounding context. For further details, please refer to paragraphs 2.1 to 2.11 above.

Environment

3.6. The Proposed Development would not cause any nuisance to the neighbourhood and would not incur adverse geotechnical, traffic and transport, drainage, sewerage, environmental, landscape and visual impacts to the surrounding areas. For further details, kindly refer to paragraphs 1.20 to 1.38 above.

3.7. The Proposed Development, will promote the planning intentions of the AGR, as certain area of the Site will be designated for greenery, plantation and agricultural purposes, which would otherwise be impossible at the Site as it has been hard paved and occupied with temporary structures for many years. For further details, kindly refer to paragraphs 1.34 to 1.37 above.

4. Compliance with the "Owner's Consent/Notification" Requirements

- 4.1. We, the applicant of this application, are the sole beneficial and legal owner of the Site. Please refer to **Attachments 6 and 7**, for the supporting documents of our ownership.
- 4.2. No additional Government land is involved in the application.

5. Background and current application

- 5.1. According to the OZP, the Site fall within the AGR zone and "Religious Institution (not elsewhere specified)" falls within column 2, i.e. uses that may be permitted with or without conditions on application to the Board.
- 5.2. The Site is currently used for Christian worshipping and related activities without a valid planning permission from the Board.
- 5.3. We have received two warning letters from the Yuen Long Lands Department (the "Lands Department") in relation to unauthorized structure(s) erected on the Site in March and May 2024, respectively (the "Warning Letters").
- 5.4. In order to comply with the relevant laws and regulations, the current application seeks the Board's planning permission under S16:
 - (a) for the Proposed Development and the Proposed Use of the Site; and
 - (b) for the temporary use of the Site (including the Temporary Structure) for the Existing Use until the commencement of Proposed Development as a transitional measure.
- 5.5. We would be grateful if the Board could grant us the above planning permissions.

6. Previous Application

6.1. The Remaining Portion of Lot No. 1236 (which forms part of the Site) is the subject of 1 previous application. The application (Case No. A/DPA/YL-TT/52) was for residential development which is not relevant to the current application. The application for permission (S16) was approved in June 1994. However, according to the Town Planning Board Secretariat, the planning permission expired on 17 June 1996 as the approved developed development has not been commenced with reference to TPB Guidelines No. 35D "Extension of Time for Commencement of Development" and the planning permission has not been renewed. This current S.16 application is not connected to the aforementioned application.

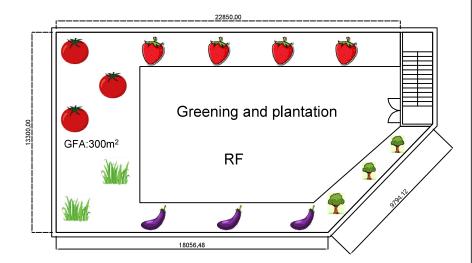


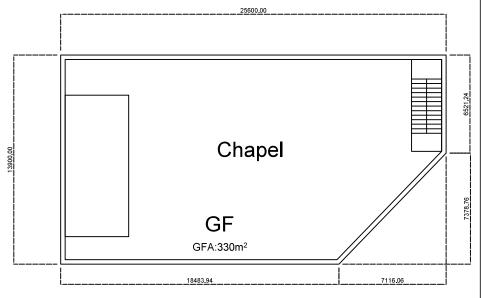


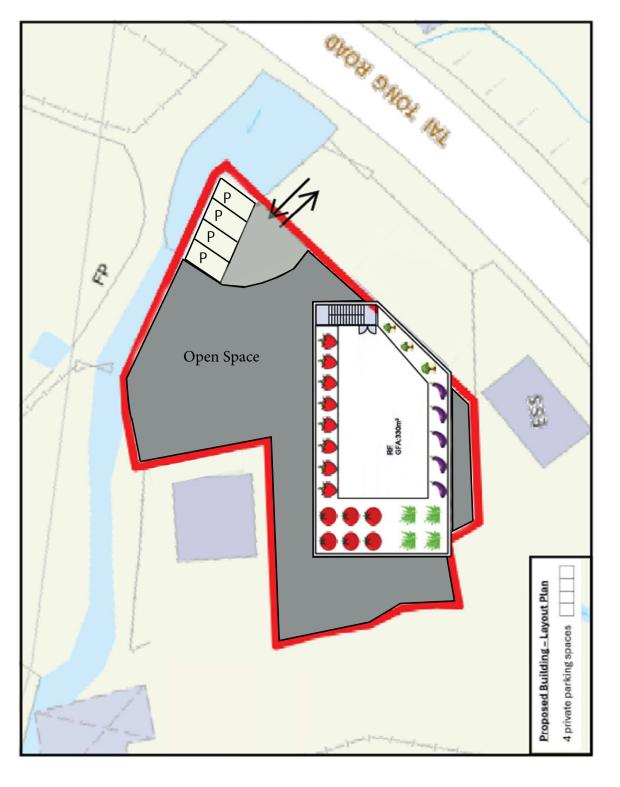
PROPOSED BUILDING – LAYOUT PLANS

If such application(s) is approved, it will be subject to such terms and conditions, including amongst others the payment of waiver fee, administrative fee or premium, as may be imposed by the Lands Department.

(i.e. the Proposed Building to be built) will be a permanent building and for permanent use. We will submit the relevant applications to the Lands Department, including application for a land exchanges, if necessary, after the planning permission has been obtained from the Board.

While for the temporary use of the Site (i.e. the Temporary Structure) prior to the commencement of the construction of the Proposed Building (as transitional measure), we will submit the relevant applications to the Lands Department to permit the structure(s) erected and/or regularise any irregularities on Site, including to apply for a short term waiver, if necessary, after the planning permission has been obtained from the Board.

2. Comments from the Urban Design & Landscape Section (UD&L)

We would reserve our comment upon receipt of the required landscape technical information in accordance with "Guidance notes on the application for permission under Section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance (Cap. 131)" for consideration.

Please refer to **Attachment 1** enclosed herewith which show (i) a picture of the existing condition of the Site and (ii) a photomontage with the Proposed Building for reference only.

The Site is already well-developed and currently hard paved with shrub planting. There are no existing mature trees at the Site.

The Proposed Development will not involve filling of land, alteration of existing building, excavation, diversion of stream, site formation or tree felling.

Significant adverse landscape impact on landscape and landscape resources arising from the Proposed Development is not anticipated.

In order to enhance the overall landscape quality, soft landscaped planters and greenery are proposed to be planted on the Proposed Building's façade and on the rooftop.

3. Comments from the Home and Youth Affairs Bureau (HYAB)

Having searching the web, We are unable to locate any official website/ social media of the Applicant DKM CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP LIMITED (錦綉基督徒團契有限公司). To facilitate our consideration whether the Applicant is a bona fide religious organisation, please ask the Applicant to provide us the Memorandum of Association ("MOA").

Please refer to the **Attachment 2** for the MOA of DKM Christian Fellowship Limited for your consideration.

4. Comments from the Transport Department (TD)

(i) As per the parking requirements for churches outlined in the HKPSG, up to 1 car parking space for every 16 seats or equivalent shall be provided. The applicant should advise how many seats would be provided for the subject development and review whether the currently proposal is adequate for its daily operation.

It is respectfully submitted that, as mentioned in our Planning Statement:

- (a) we currently have around 60 regular members in Hong Kong, including children, youth and adults;
- (b) the Proposed Building is designed to accommodate a maximum of 100 Christian worshippers; and
- (c) it is currently expected that there will be one worship session every Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday. Each session will normally be participated by 50 Christian worshippers.

According to the Hong Kong Planning Standards and Guidelines, among others, (i) as a general principle, parking should be provided at a level which will not unduly attract potential passengers to use private vehicles in preference to public transport; and (ii) the provision of parking for community facilities should generally be limited to operational requirements. Users of community facilities will generally be expected to use public transport or public car parks.

The Site is right next to Tai Tong Road and is easily accessible by minibus, K66 bus route operated by MTR and on foot. In the future most visitors are expected to access the Site by means of public transportation and on foot (as in the past).

As the HKPSG requires up to 1 (i.e. 0 to 1) car parking space for every 16 seats, we propose to have 2 parking spaces¹ reserved only for operational requirements of the church. Visitors are generally not expected to park their cars at the Site, except with prior approval from us.

Given the availability of public transport services in the vicinity, the currently proposal is adequate for our daily operation.

(ii) it is noted that the proposed development does not provide any loading and unloading spaces. As per the loading and unloading requirements for churches outlined in the HKPSG, one to two bays (9m x 3.5m) for small coaches are required. The applicant should clarify whether loading and unloading activities (e.g. refuse collection) will be necessary for daily operations.

Loading and unloading activities

Routine or regular loading and unloading activities (including refuse collection) are not expected for our daily operations in the future for the following reasons:

We wish to clarify that the visitors/users at the Site are transient in nature who only stay at the Site during worship sessions. It is currently expected that there will be only one worship session every Wednesday, Saturday and

¹ We have previously proposed to have 4 parking spaces at the Site, but as a bay (9m x 3.5m) for small coach is required by HKPSG, we have changed the 4 parking spaces to 2 parking spaces and a bay for small coach. Please refer to Attachment 3 for the revised plan and drawing.

Sunday, and each session will normally be participated by 50 Christian worshippers only. Given the Site is only intended to be used as a place for worship, and no food/ goods/ services will be sold/provided at the Site, the need for supplies is minimal.

It is expected that there may only be negligible delivery of small items of basic goods to the Site in the future, as was in the past. This delivery had been done by light goods vehicles during time outside worshipping sessions in the past. Going forward, similar practice is expected to be adapted. Hence, the current 4 parking spaces will be adequate for this purpose.

Similarly, as no food/goods/services would be sold/provided at the Site, minimal refuse is expected to be generated at the Site. A refuse collection point will not be required within our Site. Notwithstanding this, there is also a public refuse collection point near the Site (approximately 100m away). In the past as the refuse is of small quantity, we have delivered our garbage/refuse to the refuse collection point on foot.

Bay for small coach

As requested, we also designate a bay (9mx3.5m) for small coach. As such, we have reduced originally proposed parking spaces from 4 parking spaces to 2 parking spaces.

It is very seldom we have small coach carrying out loading/ unloading within our Site in the last 10 years. In the rare occasion that a small coach is expected to be parked at the Site for a temporary period of time, we will ensure the other parking spaces are not occupied such that sufficient space would be

reserved for the small coach for entering or exiting the Site.

Please refer to **Attachment 3** enclosed herewith for the revised plan.

5. Comments from the Environmental Protection Department (EPD)

Please clarify whether toilets will be provided at the Site, if affirmative, please confirm whether septic tank and soakaway system will be provided and whether the septic tank and soakaway system will be designed and constructed according to the requirements of EPD's ProPECC PN 1/23, including requirements for minimum clearance distance, percolation test and certification by Authorized Person.

It is respectfully submitted that no toilets will be provided at the Site or within the Proposed Building and no additional septic tank and soakaway system will be required at the Site for the Proposed Development.

Currently, we have toilet facilities inside the 3-storey small house situated on Section C of Lot No. 1236 in D.D. 117, which is also owned by us and is just adjacent to the Site. For the avoidance of doubt, this lot is not within the Site nor subject to the current S16 application, and it has an existing septic tank and soakaway system. The said small house was erected in accordance with Building Licence No.707 (dated 25 June 1975, as modified and rectified) and was certified to have complied with the conditions of the license on 14 April 1981. In the future, we expect to continue to use this existing toilet facilities as we have done in the past.

In the event that additional septic tank and soakaway system is required at the Site in the future, we will comply with the relevant laws and regulations, and ensure that it will be designed and constructed according to the requirements of EPD's ProPECC PN 1/23, including requirements for minimum clearance distance, percolation test and certification by Authorized Person.

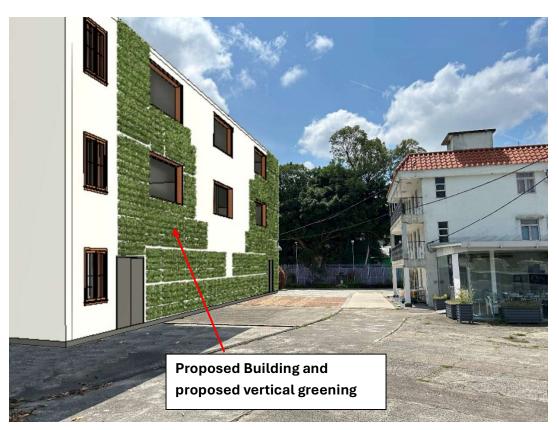

- 1. The name of the Company is "DKM CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP LIMITED 錦绣基督徒團契有限公司" (hereinafter referred to as the "Church").
- 2. The Registered Office of the Church will be situate in Hong Kong.
- 3. The objects for which the Church is established are:
 - (a) To pay respects to, worship and serve the Holy Father, Holy Son and Holy Spirit as true God and Blessed Trinity.
 - (b) To build up Christian Belief and Virtue in accordance with the truths in the Holy Bible.
 - (c) To preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and call upon the people to accept Christ as their Saviour and Lord.
 - (d) To teach people to keep all that Jesus has commanded.
 - (e) To carry out, establish, construct, maintain, improve, manage and superintend, or to assist in the carrying out, establishment, construction, maintenance, improvement, management, or superintendence of churches, chapels, hospitals, centers and stations for charitable purposes.
 - (f) To establish, undertake, superintend administer, contribute to, amalgamate with, or otherwise assist any charitable institutions or undertakings sharing similar basis of belief Provided that none of the funds of the Church shall be paid to nor shall the Church be amalgamated with any such institution or undertaking which pays or

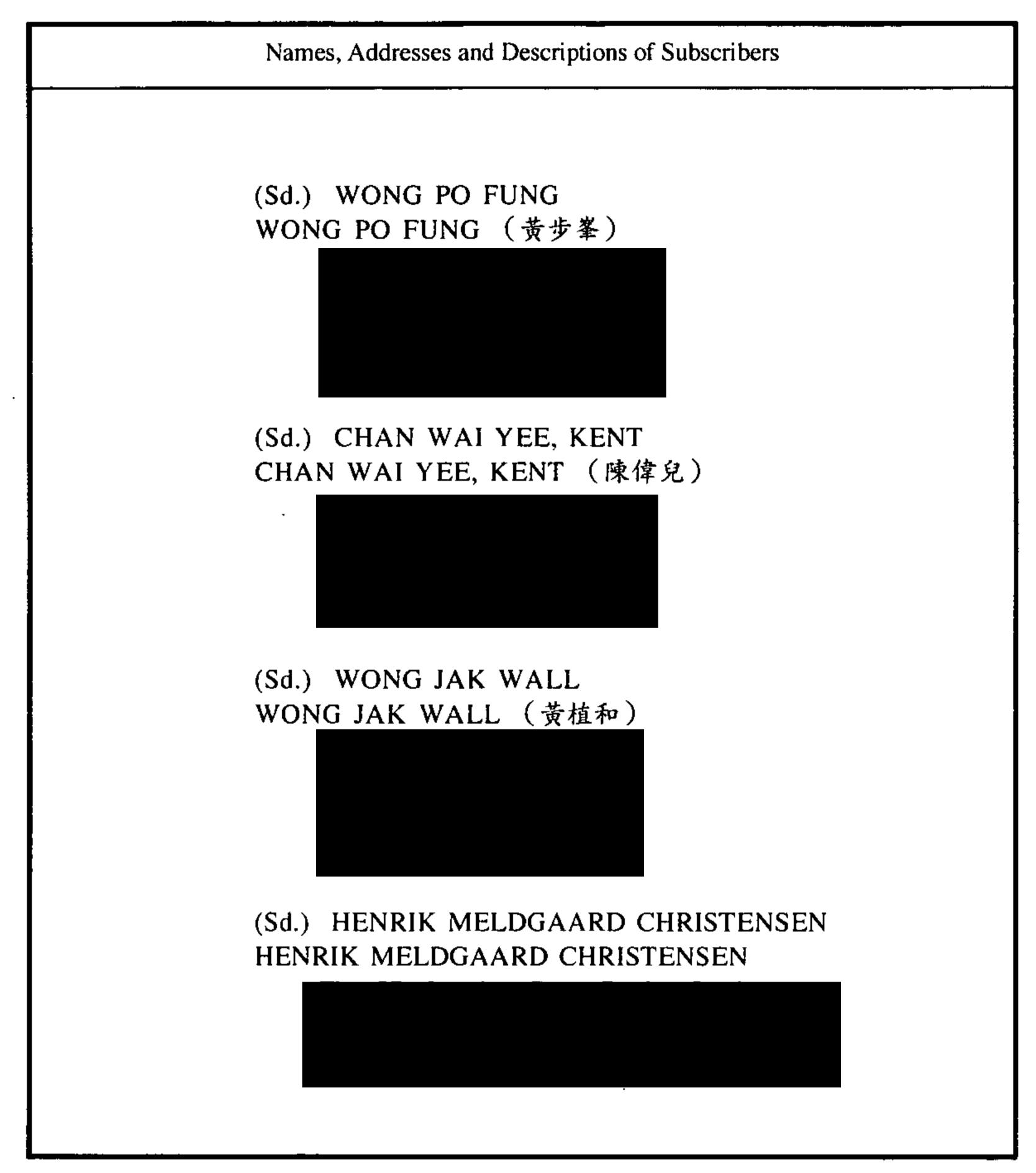
transfers directly or indirectly any part of its income or property by way of dividend, bonus, or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to its members.

- (g) To promote, support, contribute to or otherwise assist any Christian activities or acts of charity (which acts shall include such acts shown to the member(s) of the Church) as the Council of the Church may from time to time think fit.
- (h) To admit any persons to be members of the Church on such terms, and to confer on them such rights and privileges as may seem expedient.
- (i) To hire and employ all classes of persons (including the members of the Church) considered necessary for the purpose of the Church and to pay to them and to other persons in return for services rendered to the Church, salaries, wages, gratuities and pensions.
- (j) To purchase, take on lease or in exchange, hire or otherwise acquire any real and personal property which may be deemed necessary or convenient for any of the purposes of the Church. To construct, maintain, develop and alter any houses, buildings, lands or works necessary or convenient for the purposes of the Church.
- (k) To sell, manage, lease, mortgage, charge, dispose of, or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property of the Church.
- (1) To grant, sell, convey, assign, surrender, exchange, partition, yield up, mortgage, demise, reassign, transfer or otherwise dispose of any lands, buildings, messuages, tenements, mortgages, debentures, funds, shares, or securities, which are for the time being vested in or belonging to the Church upon such terms as the Church may deem fit in furtherance of the objects of the Church.
- (m) To borrow any money required for the purposes of the Church upon such terms and on such securities as may be determined.
- (n) To invest the moneys of the Church not immediately required upon such securities or otherwise in such manner as may from time to time be determined.
- (o) To draw, make, accept, indorse, discount, execute and issue promissory notes, drafts, bills of exchange, warrants, cheques and other negotiable or transferable instruments.
- (p) To raise money by subscription or other lawful means for the purposes of the Church.
- (q) To accept and receive offerings, donationspayments and gifts (of whatever nature or kind) and bequests to the Church.

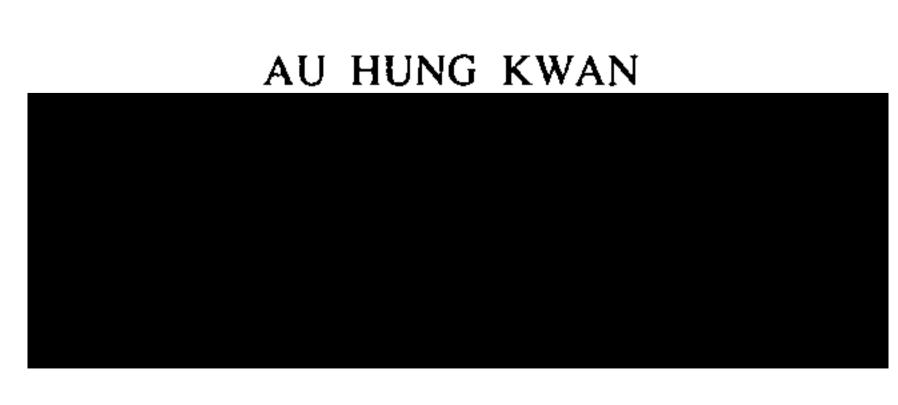
- (r) To refrain from having any connection with any political body or party.
- (s) To carry on and do any of the above matters and things either alone or in conjunction with others and either as principal or agent or otherwise.
- (t) To do all such other lawful things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objects set out above.
- 4. The income and property of the Church, whencesoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Church as set forth in this Memorandum of Association; and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend, bonus, or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to the members of the Church. Provided that nothing herein shall prevent the payment, in good faith, of reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or servant of the Church, or to any member of the Church, in return for any service actually rendered to the Church, nor prevent the payment of interest at a rate not exceeding the prevailing rate applicable to Hong Kong dollar savings account on money lent or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised or let by any member to the Church; but so that no member of the Council or Governing Body of the Church shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Church, or any office of the Church paid by fees and that no remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the Church to any member of such Council or Governing Body except repayment of out-of pocket expenses and interest at the ratio aforesaid on money lent or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised or let to the Church.
- 5. The liability of the members is limited.
- 6. Every member of the Church undertakes to contribute to the assets of the Church in the event of the same being wound up during the time that he or she is a member or within one year afterwards for payment of the debts and liabilities of the Church contracted before the time at which he or she ceased to be a member, and of the costs, charges, and expenses of winding up the same, and for the adjustment of the rights of the contributories amongst themselves, such amount as may be required not exceeding the sum of ten dollars.
- 7. If upon the winding up of the Church there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Church, but shall be given or transferred to some other charity or charities having objects similar to the objects of the Church, and which shall prohibit the distribution of its or their income and property amongst its or their members to an extent as least as great as is imposed on the Church under or by virtue of Clause 4 hereof, such charity or charities to be determined by the Council of the Church before the time of dissolution, or in default thereof by such judge of the High Court of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region as may have or acquire jurisdiction in the matter and if and so far as effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provision then to some charitable object.

8. True accounts shall be kept of the sums of money received and expended by the Church and the matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure take place, and of the property, credits and liabilities of the Church, and subject to any reasonable restrictions as to the time and manner of inspecting the same which may be imposed in accordance with the regulations of the Church for the time being, shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year the accounts of the Church for the time being, shall be open to the inspection of the members. Once at least in every year the accounts of the Church shall be examined and the correctness of the Balance Sheet ascertained by one or more authorised auditor or auditors.

PRELIMINARY

- 1. In these Articles:-
 - (a) "The Ordinance" means the Companies Ordinance (Chapter 32) of the Revised Edition and any modification and amendment or re-enactment thereof.
 - (b) Table C of the Companies Ordinance shall not apply.
 - (c) "The Church" means "DKM CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP LIMITED 錦绣基督徒團契有限公司".
 - (d) "The Council" means the Board of directors.
 - (e) "Council members" means the directors.
 - (f) Words importing the singular number shall include the plural and vice versa.
 - (g) Words importing the masculine gender shall include the feminine gender.
 - (h) Words importing persons shall include corporation.
 - (i) Unless the context otherwise requires, words or expressions contained in these Articles shall bear the same meaning as in the Ordinance or any

statutory modification thereof in force at the date at which these Articles become binding on the Church.

OBJECTS

 The Church is established for the purposes set out in the Memorandum of Association.

MEMBERS

- 3. For the purpose of registration, the number of members of the Church is declared to be unlimited.
- 4. The subscribers to the Memorandum of Association and such other persons as the Council shall admit to membership shall be members of the Church.
- 5. When any person desires to be admitted to membership of the Church he must sign and deliver to the Church an application for admission framed in such terms as the Council shall require.
- 6. No person shall be admitted as a member of the Church unless:
 - (a) He accepts each of the Belief as set out in Article 61 in the Articles of Association; and
 - (b) He has been approved by the Council as being one suitable to be admitted to membership of the Church.

The Council shall have full discretion to the admission of any person to membership.

- 7. The rights and privileges of each and every member shall be personal and shall not be transferable by his own act or by operation of law.
- 8. Every member shall exercise the best of his ability to promote the objects of the Church, and shall observe all regulations and by-laws of the Church.
- 9. Subject to Article 11 herein
 - (a) any member may apply to withdraw his membership from the Church by giving one month's notice in writing to the Honorary Secretary of the Council of his intention so to do, and upon the expiration of the notice the Council may, unless with reasons to the contrary, approve his application and he shall cease to be a member of the Church from a date specified by the Council.
 - (b) Any member not attending the regular Meeting of the Church for a period of one year shall at the expiration of such a year be deemed to have applied to withdraw his membership from the Church and the

Council may deal with such application in the manner as provided in Article 9(a) herein UNLESS within 14 days' after the expiration of such a year he has explained his absence to the Council in writing with good cause shown to the satisfaction of the Council.

- 10. A person may be excommunicated from the Church and removed from the Register of Members (with retrospective effect if necessary) from a date specified by the Council if whilst being a member he is guilty of any of the following excommunicable wrongs, namely:-
 - (a) he has been convicted by a court of law of an offence involving moral turpitude which in the opinion of the Council justified excommunication or
 - (b) he has been leading a life that in the opinion of the Council renders him no longer able to bear testimony as a Christian or
 - (c) he has in the opinion of the Council failed to observe or accept any of the statements of the faith, or each of the Belief as set out in Article 61 in the Articles of Association, or
 - (d) his behaviour or conduct has been in the opinion of the Council dishonourable or improper or injurious to the interest, benefit, character, or good name of the Church.

PROVIDED that before any person shall be excommunicated from the Church and removed from the Register of Members, he shall be given an opportunity to attend before the Council in order to show cause why he should not be removed from the Register of Members and shall be given advice calling from repentance, and shall either have failed to give a satisfactory reason as to why he should not be removed from the Register of Members or shall have rejected or disobeyed the advice tendered PROVIDED FURTHER that no member may be excommunicated from the Church without the approval of all of the Members for the time being of the Council PROVIDED FURTHER that in the event of a member being excommunicated from the Church the Council shall have full right and liberty to notify all members of the Church and all other Christian Churches or organisations of such excommunication and the reasons thereof PROVIDED FURTHER that the decision of excommunication of the Council shall not take effect until the expiration of one month from the date of the member affected is informed of the same in order that he may appeal to the members of the Church in an extraordinary general meeting held in accordance with the articles provided herein.

11. Any person ceasing to be a member for any reason may, with the approval of the Council, apply to become a member again.

GENERAL MEETINGS

12. A General Meeting shall be held once in every calendar year at such time (not

being more than fifteen months after the holding of the last preceding General Meeting) and at such place as the Council may from time to time determine.

- 13. The Honorary Secretary of the Council shall give at least twenty-one days notice in writing to all members of the Church announcing the date of the Annual General Meeting.
- 14. Business of the Annual General Meeting will be:-
 - (a) To confirm minutes of the previous General Meetings and to discuss matters arising therefrom;
 - (b) To receive and approve the Statement of Accounts audited;
 - (c) To appoint Auditors for the ensuing year and to fix their remuneration; and
 - (d) To elect (when necessary) Members of the Council.
- 15. An Extraordinary General Meeting may be convened:-
 - (a) By the Council;
 - (b) (i) At the request in writing of members of the Church representing not less than one-fifth of the total registered members at the date of the deposit of the requisition.
 - (ii) The requisition must state the reasons and the objects of the meeting, and must be signed by the requisitionists and deposited at the registered office of the Church.
- 16. An Extraordinary General Meeting shall be convened within 21 days upon receipt of the requisition and the Honorary Secretary of the Church shall notify all members in writing in this connection not later than 14 days before the meeting.
- 17. The accidental omission to give notice of a meeting or failure to observe the prescribed period for such a notice to, or the non-receipt of notice of a meeting by, any member shall not invalidate the proceedings of any meeting.

PROCEEDINGS AT GENERAL MEETINGS

- 18. Subject to Article 19 herein, no business shall be transacted at any general meeting unless a quorum of members is present at the time when the meeting proceeds to business; until otherwise determined by the Church in general meeting, the quorum shall be half of the members for the time being of the Church.
- 19. If within half an hour from the time appointed for the meeting a quorum is not

present, the meeting, if convened upon the requisition of members, shall be dissolved; in any other case it shall stand adjourned to the same day in the next week, at the same time and place, and if at the adjourned meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour from the time appointed for the meeting the members present shall be a quorum.

- 20. The Chairman of the Council and in his absence, the Honorary Treasurer shall preside as Chairman at every general meeting of the Church. If at any meeting the Chairman or Honorary Treasurer shall not be present within 20 minutes after the time appointed for holding the meeting, one of the Members of the Council shall preside, or if no such Member be present or willing to take the chair, the members present shall choose one of their members to be Chairman.
- 21. The Chairman may, with the consent of any meeting at which a quorum is present (and shall if so directed by the meeting), adjourn the meeting from time to time and from place to place, but no business shall be transacted at any adjourned meeting other than the business left unfinished at the meeting from which the adjournment took place. When a meeting is adjourned for ten days or more, notice of the adjourned meeting shall be given as in the case of an original meeting. Save as aforesaid it shall not be necessary to give any notice of an adjournment or of the business to be transacted at an adjourned meeting.
- 22. At any general meeting a resolution put to the vote of the meeting shall be decided on a show of hands, unless a poll is (before or on the declaration of the result of the show of hands) demanded by at least three members present in person entitled to vote and, unless a poll is so demanded, a declaration by the chairman that a resolution has, on a show of hands, been carried, or carried unanimously, or by a particular majority, or lost, and an entry to that effect in the book of the proceedings of the Church, shall be conclusive evidence of the fact, without proof of the number or proportion of the votes recorded in favour of, or against, that resolution.
- 23. If a poll is duly demanded it shall be taken in such manner as the chairman directs, and the result of the poll shall be deemed to be the resolution of the meeting at which the poll was demanded.
- 24. In the case of an equality of votes, whether on a show of hands or on a poll, the Chairman of the meeting, at which the show of hands takes place or at which the poll is demanded, shall be entitled to a second or casting vote.
- 25. A poll demanded on the election of a chairman, or on a question of adjournment, shall be take forthwith. A poll demanded on any other question shall be taken at such time as the chairman of the meeting directs.

VOTES OF MEMBERS

- 26. Every member shall have one vote.
- 27. A member of unsound mind, or in respect of whom an order has been made by

any court having jurisdiction in lunacy, shall not be entitled to vote.

- No member shall be entitled to vote at any general meeting unless all moneys presently due and payable by him to the Church have been paid.
- 29. No member shall be entitled to appoint a proxy to act on his behalf.

COUNCIL

- 30. The number of Members in Council shall not be less than two nor more than twenty.
- 31. Members of the Council must be members of the Church and shall hold office for life unless they vacated in terms of Article 46 herein.
- 32. The persons hereinafter named shall be the First Members of the Council, that is to say:-

WONG PO FUNG (黄步峯)
CHAN WAI YEE, KENT (陳偉兒)
WONG JAK WALL (黄植和)
HENRIK MELDGAARD CHRISTENSEN

who shall hold office for life unless they vacate in terms of Article 46 herein.

- 33. The Council shall elect among themselves one Chairman, one Honorary Secretary and one Honorary Treasurer and other offices as the Council may deem fit Provided that a member of the Council may hold more than one offices Provided Further that the First Chairman shall be Wong Po Fung (黃步峯) Provided Further that the First Honorary Secretary shall be Chan Wai Yee, Kent (陳偉兒) Provided Further that the First Honorary Treasurer shall be Chan Wai Yee, Kent (陳偉兒). The persons elected shall hold office for life unless they vacate in terms of Article 46 herein.
- 34. The Chairman may preside at all meetings of the Church.
- 35. The Honorary Treasurer shall deputise for the Chairman in the latter's absence.
- 36. The Honorary Secretary shall keep all records, except financial, of the Church, and shall be responsible for their correctness. He shall keep minutes of all general and Council meetings.
- 37. The Honorary Treasurer shall keep all funds and collect and disburse all moneys on behalf of the Church and shall keep an account of all monetary transactions, and shall be responsible for their correctness. All moneys received by the Honorary Treasurer shall be paid into bank to be decided by the Council. The Honorary Treasurer may be authorised by the Council to have an amount of petty cash for sundry expenses.

38. The Council shall be the supreme authority of the Church when the general meeting is not being held.

NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

- 39. Subject to Article 46 herein, election of the Members of the Council when necessary is to take place at any general meeting of the Church in accordance with the regulations stated below:—
 - (a) One month before the general meeting, the Council shall nominate a list of persons to new Members of the Council and the same shall be sent to each of the registered members.
 - (b) On receipt of the list mentioned in (a) above, any member who is disagreeable with any proposed person in the list may, not later than two weeks before the date of general meeting, lodge his objection at the registered office of the Church.
 - (c) On receipt of the objection and after due consideration thereof, the Council may or may not nominate another person in place of the one being objected.

DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

- 40. The Members of the Council shall meet not less than once every six months for the dispatch of business, adjourn, and otherwise regulate their meetings, as they think fit and determine the quorum necessary for the transaction of business. Until otherwise determined, three quarters of the Members for the time being of the Council shall constitute a quorum. Questions or resolutions arising at any meeting shall be decided unanimously by Members of the Council present at the meeting. A Member of the Council may, and the Honorary Secretary on the requisition of a Member of the Council shall, at any time summon a meeting of the Council.
- 41. The Council shall be responsible for:—
 - (a) setting up policies of the Church;
 - (b) executing or implementing the matters decided in the general meetings;
 - (c) running of the Church;
 - (d) appointing preacher and other workers, and fixing their salaries and the areas of their duties;
 - (e) approving applications for membership;
 - (f) managing the financial affairs of the Church
 - (g) framing by-laws for the running of the Church; and

- (h) furnishing an annual report which shall include a financial statement and a financial budget.
- 42. The Council shall be entrusted with the general management and carrying on of business of the Church, and shall have full power to do all such acts and things and enter into all such contracts and engagements on behalf of the Church as it may consider necessary or desirable and may also appoint and remove or suspend any preachers, officers, clerks, accountants, agents, servants and to other employees.
- 43. The Council in addition to the powers and authorities by these Articles or otherwise expressly conferred upon them may exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may exercised or done by the Church in General Meeting subject nevertheless to provisions of the Companies Ordinance (Chapter 32), to these Articles, and to any regulations from time to time made by the Church in General Meeting, provided that no such regulation so made shall invalidate any prior act of the Council which would have been valid if such regulation had not been made.
- 44. Without prejudice to the general powers conferred by the preceding Articles and the other powers conferred by these Articles, it is hereby expressly declared that the Council shall have the following powers, that is to say, power:-
 - (a) To pay the costs, charges and expenses preliminary and incidental to the promotion, formation, establishment and registration of the Church.
 - (b) To purchase or otherwise acquire for the Church or sell or otherwise dispose of any property, rights or privileges which the Church is authorised to acquire at such price and generally on such terms and conditions as they shall think fit.
 - (c) To engage, dismiss and fix the salaries or emoluments of the employees of the Church.
 - (d) To institute, conduct, defend, compromise or abandon any legal proceedings by or against the Church or its officers, or otherwise concerning the affairs of the Church, and also to compound and allow time for payment or satisfaction of any debts due to, and of any claims or demands by or against the Church.
 - (e) To refer any claims or demands by or against the Church to arbitration and observe and perform the awards.
 - (f) To make and give receipts, releases and other discharges for moneys payable to the Church, and for claims and demands of the Church.
 - (g) To invest, lend or otherwise deal with any of the moneys or property of the Church in such manner as they think fit having regard to the Church's Memorandum of Association and from time to time to vary or realise any such investment.

- (h) To borrow money on behalf of the Church, and to pledge, mortgage, charge or hypothecate any of the property of the Church.
- (i) To open current and saving accounts with any bank or banks for the Church and to advance any money to the Church with or without interest and upon such terms and conditions as they shall think fit.
- (j) To enter into all such negotiations and contracts, and rescind and vary all such contracts, and execute and do all such acts, deeds and things in the name and on behalf of the Church as they may consider expedient for, or in relation to, any of the matters aforesaid, or otherwise for the purposes of the Church.
- (k) To sell, improve, manage, exchange, lease, let, mortgage, charge or turn to account all or any part of the land, property, rights and privileges of the Church.
- (1) From time to time provide for the management of the affairs of the Church abroad in such manner as they think fit, and in particular to appoint any persons to be the attorneys or agents of the Church with such powers (including power to sub-delegate) and upon such terms as they think fit.
- (m) From time to time to make, vary or repeal rules any by-laws for the regulation of the business of the Church, its officers and servants.
- (n) To delegate any or all of the powers herein to any member of the Council or other person or persons as the Council may at any time think fit.
- (o) To appoint any person or persons to be the preacher or preachers or other office bearer or bearers of the Church either for a fixed term or without any limitation as to the period for which they are to hold such office in such terms remuneration Or other benefits as the Council shall think fit.
- 45. In case the office of the Chairman becomes vacant the Honorary Treasurer shall become the acting Chairman until the Council elect among themselves a new Chairman.

DISQUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

- 46. The office of Member of the Council shall be vacated in the following events:-
 - (a) If the Member should be absent from the regular meetings of the Council for twelve months without having given any reasonable excuse in writing to the Council at the earliest opportunity, the office of such Member shall be vacated; or
 - (b) If he has been convicted by a court of law of an offence involving moral turpitude which in the opinion of The Council justifies removal from

office or if he is leading a life that in the opinion of the Council renders him no longer able to bear testimony as a Christian or if he has in the opinion of the Council failed to observe any of the statement of faith, regulations or by laws of the church or if his behaviour or conduct has been in the opinion of the Council dishonourable or improper or injurious to the interest, benefit, character, or good name of the Church AND he shall either have failed to give satisfactory reason as to why he should not be removed from office or shall have rejected or disobeyed the advice calling for repentance given by the Council AND by a resolution passed by a three quarters of the other members for the time being of the Council for such removal; or

- (c) If he is found lunatic or becomes of unsound mind; or
- (d) If by notice in writing to the Church he resigns his office; or
- (e) If he becomes prohibited from being a Member of the Council by reason of any order made under Section 275 of the Ordinance; or
- (f) If he ceases to be a member of the Church.

PROVIDED THAT in case of all Members of the Council vacate their offices the Church may by ordinary resolution nominate and elect an adhoc committee to prepare for the nomination and election of new Council Members to be held at the next extraordinary general meeting of the Church.

APPOINTMENT OF ELDERS & DEACONS

- 47. (a) Any members of the Church may be appointed to be Deacon or Elder of the Church by the Chairman of the Council. The aforesaid appointment shall be made by the laying of hands at a congregational meeting on Sunday specially convened for such purpose.
 - (b) Any Deacon or Elder so appointed shall cease to be the same if he ceases to be member of the Church.

ACCOUNTS

- 48. The Council shall cause proper books of account to be kept with respect to:—
 - (a) all sums of money received and expended by the Church and the matters in respect or which such receipts and expenditure take place;
 - (b) all sales and purchases of goods, lands and other things whatsoever by the Church; and
 - (c) the assets and liabilities of the Church.
- 49. At the Annual General Meeting in every year the Council shall lay before the

members a proper Income and Expenditure Account for the period since the last preceding account made up to a date not more than nine months before such meeting, together with a proper Balance Sheet made up as at the same date. Every such Balance Sheet shall be accompanied by proper reports of the Council and Auditors, and copies of such account, Balance Sheet and Report and of any other documents required by law to be annexed or attached thereto or to accompany the same shall not less than seven clear days before the date of the Meeting be sent to the Auditors and to all other persons entitled to receive notices of General Meeting.

AUDIT

50. Auditors shall be appointed and their duties regulated in accordance with Sections 131,140 and 141 of the Ordinance.

ALTERATIONS TO ARTICLES

The Articles shall not be altered except by a special resolution at a General Meeting.

THE SEAL & CHEQUES

- 52. The seal of the Church shall not be affixed to any instrument except by the authority of a resolution of the Council, and in the presence of the Chairman or such other members of the Council as the Council may appoint for the purpose; and the Chairman or such other members of the Council as aforesaid shall sign every instrument to which the seal of the Church is so affixed in their presence.
- 53. Unless otherwise determined by the Council, all cheques, bills of exchange, promissory notes and other negotiable instruments issued or required, to be signed, endorsed or accepted or otherwise negotiated by the Church shall be signed by two Members of the Council appointed by the Council.

NOTICES

- 54. A notice may be given by the Church to any member either personally or by sending it by ordinary post to his registered address, or (if he has no registered address within Hong Kong) to the address, if any, within Hong Kong supplied by him to the Church for the giving of notices to him.
- 55. When a notice is sent by post, service of the notice shall be deemed to be effected by properly addressing, prepaying, and posting a letter containing the notice, and to have been effected at the expiration of twenty-four hours after the letter containing the same is posted.
- Provided that a notice addressed generally "to all members" of the Church and posted once on the notice board of the Church on any Sunday shall be deemed to be well served on them at the expiration of forty-eight hours after it is so posted up.

Notices of every general meeting shall be given in the same manner hereinbefore authorized to (a) every member except those members who (having no registered address within Hong Kong) have not supplied to the church an address within Hong Kong for the giving of notices to them, and (b) the auditors for the time being of the Church. No other persons shall be entitled to receive notices of general meetings.

WINDING UP

58. The provision of Clause 7 of the Memorandum of Association relation to the winding up or the dissolution of the Church shall have effect and be observed as if the same are repeated in these Articles.

Exclusion

59. The Seventh Schedule to the Companies Ordinance (Chapter 32) shall not apply to this Church of charitable organization.

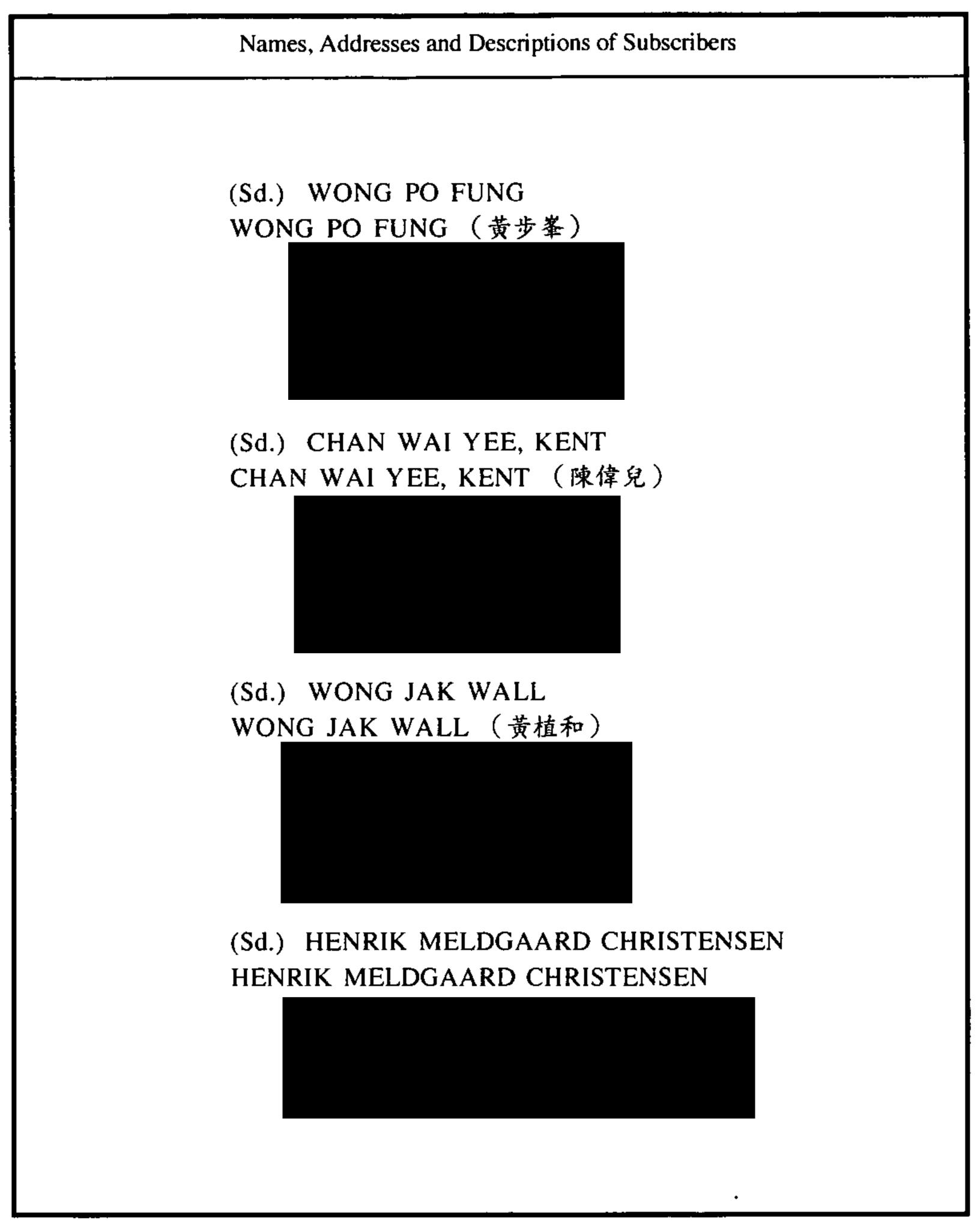

- (j) The indwelling and work of the Holy Spirit in the believer.
- (k) The one Holy Universal Church which is the Body of Christ.
- (1) The expectation of the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.

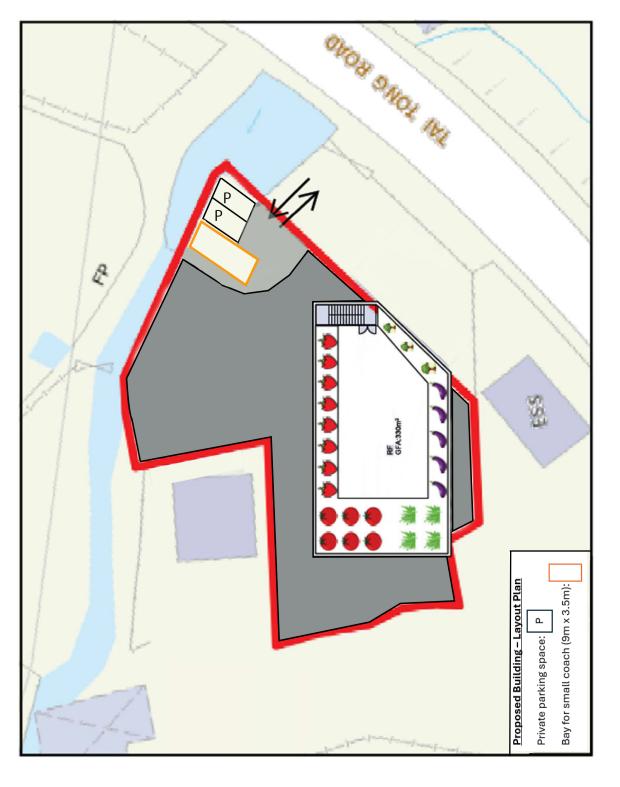

Dear Secretary of Town Planning Board,

We refer to the captioned application. Unless otherwise defined herein, capitalised terms used in this submission shall have the same meanings as those defined in our planning statement ("Planning Statement").

We wish to provide the following further information for your consideration:

- 1. The proposed usage of the Site will be for Christian worshipping and related activities. The aforesaid related activities include bible studies and bible sharing sessions.
- 2. Each worshipping session will be around 3 to 4 hours.
- 3. Generally there may be 1 to 2 volunteers at the Site to do cleaning and carry out maintenance of the Site from time to time (generally between 9am to 9pm).
- 4. We bought the Site in 2004. The "worshipping activities" have started in around 2009/2010.
- 5. We will separate the Site from the lots DD 117 1232 S.B, DD117 Lot 1234 and DD117 Lot 1237 RP (which are adjacent to the Site) with fencing.
- 6. The major reasons that we wish to apply for a permanent use/development under section 16 of the Town Planning Ordinance (as opposed to a temporary use/development) are as follows:

- a) we are a long established Christian organisation in Hong Kong and a charitable institution registered under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance (Cap 112) since 2004. We intend to use the Site in a sustainable manner in the future (for at least another 20 years). Whilst a temporary use/develop of land is generally for a period not exceeding 3 years, which may not be able to meet our long-term need. Hence, having a permanent building (as opposed to a temporary structure) is in line with our long-term commitment;
- b) as mentioned in paragraph 5.3 of our Planning Statement, we have received two warning letters from the Yuen Long Lands Department in relation to unauthorized structure(s), i.e. the Temporary Structure erected on the Site, in March and May 2024, respectively. In order for us to continue to serve the local Christian community and further our ministry, it is necessary for us to regularize the current use by submission of this Application. We wish to regularize and legalize the current usage in compliance with all the relevant law and regulation once and for all;
- c) we intend to build a permanent worshipping center that complies with the all the applicable laws and regulations, including, among others, building, fire and safety regulations. Considering the capital and resources to be invested into the project, a permanent land use change would be more sensible. A temporary land conversion may not allow us to achieve this purpose. Further, permanent structures are typically built to higher safety standards and are more durable against weather conditions, ensuring a safe environment for the worshippers;
- d) it would allow us to better utilize our resources and devise a plan for the church. Applying for temporary use/development would require us to renew/ reapply to Town Planning Board every 3 years for approval, which would create uncertainty for our commitment;
- e) a permanent building reflects a long-term commitment to the local community and provides stability for worshippers, fostering a sense of belonging to the users; and
- f) according to the Notes of the OZP, "Religious Institution (not elsewhere specified)" is a Column 2 use within the "AGR" zone. Hence, a permanent Christian Worshipping Center aligns with the town planning goals and zoning regulations.
- 7. The Proposed Building is proposed to have 3 storeys (as opposed to two storeys of the Temporary Structure) mainly for the following reasons:
 - a) We have experienced that the current Temporary Structure, which has been in place a long time ago, not being able to meet all our needs, particularly rooms that provide more privacy. A three-story building provides more space for small group bible study to be conducted simultaneously; and
 - b) A three-story building is a long-term commitment with a capacity to serve the community for many years in the future, hence reducing the need for future expansions or renovations.
- 8. There is a public toilet approximately 100 meters away from the Site, the worshippers can make use of the public toilet facility in an easy manner.
- 9. We refer to paragraph 1.16 of the Planning Statement, the community services means bible studying and worshipping.

The proposed development will be a permanent structure. This indicates that the correct procedure is to apply for a change in zoning to 'GIC' via a S.12 application.

Approval of this application would encourage other religious operations to follow the "Destroy to Build' route to development.

Recommended Advisory Clauses

- (a) prior planning permission should have been obtained before commencing the applied use at the application site (the Site);
- (b) to note the comments of the District Lands Officer/Yuen Long, Lands Department (DLO/YL, LandsD) that:
 - (i) the Site comprises Old Schedule Agricultural Lots held under the Block Government Lease which contains the restriction that no structures are allowed to be erected without the prior approval of the Government;
 - (ii) there is/are unauthorized structure(s) and/or uses on the private lots which is already subject to lease enforcement actions according to case priority. The lot owner(s) should rectify/apply for regularisation on the lease breaches as demanded by LandsD; and
 - (iii) the lot owner(s) will need to apply to LandsD to permit the structure(s) to be erected or regularize any irregularities on site. If the Religious Institution (Christian Worshipping Centre) use is temporary in nature, the applicant has to apply for a Short Term Waiver (STW) on the private land If the Religious Institution (Christian Worshipping Centre) is intended for permanent use, the applicant has to apply for a land exchange. Applications of any of the above will be considered by LandsD acting in the capacity as the landlord and there is no guarantee that such application(s) will be approved. If such application(s) is approved, it will be subject to such terms and conditions, including amongst others the payment of waiver fee, administrative fee or premium, as may be imposed by LandsD;
- (c) to note the comments of the Commissioner for Transport:
 - (i) the local track and footpath leading to the Site are not under Transport Department's purview. The applicant shall obtain consent of the owners/managing departments of the local track and footpath for using the local track and footpath as the access to the Site; and
 - (ii) sufficient manoeuvring space shall be provided within the Site. No vehicles are allowed to queue back to public roads or reverse onto/from public roads;
- (d) to note that comments of the Chief Highway Engineer/New Territories West, Highways Department (CHE/NTW, HyD):
 - (i) adequate drainage measures should be provided to prevent surface water running from the Site to the nearby public roads and drains; and
 - (ii) HyD should not be responsible for the maintenance of any access connecting the Site with Tai Tong Road;
- (e) to note the comments of the Director of Environmental Protection that:
 - (i) to implement appropriate pollution control measures to minimise any potential environmental impacts during the construction of the project. Reference could be made to relevant publications/guidelines including the Recommended Pollution Control Clauses for Construction Contracts (available at: http://www.epd.gov.hk/epd/english/environmentinhk/eia_planning/guide_ref/rpc.html) and Professional Persons Environmental Consultative Committee (ProPECC) Practice Notes 2/24 'Construction Site Drainage';

- (ii) to avoid the use of public announcement system, portable loudspeaker or any form of audio amplification system at the Site;
- (iii) to provide adequate supporting infrastructure/facilities for proper collection, treatment and disposal of waste/wastewater if any waste/wastewater are generated from the proposed use in the future. If septic tank and soakaway system will be used in case of unavailability of public sewer, its design and construction shall follow the requirements of EPD's Practice Note for Professional Person (ProPECC) PN 1/23 "Drainage Plans subject to Comment by the Environmental Protection Department" including completion of percolation test and certification by Authorized Person;
- (iv) to keep windows/doors closed during indoor religious activities, with the provision of airconditioning; and
- (v) it is the obligation of the applicant to meet the statutory requirements under relevant pollution control ordinances;
- (f) to note the comments of the Director of Food and Environmental Hygiene (DFEH) that:
 - (i) no Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD)'s facilities will be affected by the proposed use;
 - (ii) proper licence/permit issued by FEHD is required if there is any food business/catering service/activities regulated by DFEH under the Public Health and Municipal Services Ordinance (Cap. 132) and other relevant legislation for the public. Under the Food Business Regulation, Cap. 132X, a food business licence is required for the operation of the relevant type of food business listed in the Regulation (e.g. a restaurant, a fresh provision shop, etc). A Fresh Provision Shop Licence will be required in case sale of fresh, chilled or frozen beef, mutton, pork, reptiles (including live reptiles), fish (including live fish) or poultry (including live poultry)(including wholesale and retail) is involved. In case that the farm product sold at the Site are vegetables and fruits only, the fresh provision shop licence is not required. The application for licence, if acceptable by FEHD, will be referred to relevant government departments such as the Buildings Department (BD), Fire Services Department and Planning Department for comment. If there is no objection from the departments concerned, a letter of requirements will be issued to the applicant for compliance and the licence will be issued upon compliance of all the requirements;
 - (iii) proper licence issued by FEHD is required if related place of entertainment is involved. Under the Places of Public entertainment (PPE) Ordinance (Cap. 172), public entertainment means any entertainment within the meaning of this Ordinance to which the general public is admitted with or without payment. Any person who desires to keep or use any place of public entertainment for example a theatre and cinema or a place, building, erection or structure, whether temporary or permanent, on one occasion or more, capable of accommodating the public presenting or carrying on public entertainment within PPE Ordinance (Cap. 172) and its subsidiary legislation, such as a concert, opera, ballet, stage performance or other musical, dramatic or theatrical entertainment, cinematograph or laser projection display, a circus, a lecture or story-telling, an exhibition of any 1 or more of the following, namely, pictures, photographs, books, manuscripts or other documents or other things, a sporting exhibition or contest, a bazaar, a dancy party or an amusement ride and mechanical device which is designed for amusement, a Place of Public Entertainment Licence (or Temporary Place of Public Entertainment Licence) should be obtained from FEHD whatever the general public is admitted with or without

payment; and

- (iv) there should be no encroachment on the public place and no environmental nuisance should be generated to the surroundings. Its state should not be a nuisance or injurious or dangerous to health and surrounding environment. Also, for any waste generated from such activities/operation, the applicant should arrange disposal properly at their own expenses;
- (g) to note the comments of the Director of Fire Services that:
 - (i) the relevant layout plans should be incorporated with the proposed fire service installations (FSIs) to the Fire Services Department for approval;
 - (ii) the layout plans should be drawn to scale and depicted with dimensions and nature of occupancy, and the location of the proposed FSIs to be installed should be clearly marked on the layout plans; and
 - (iii) if the proposed structure(s) is required to comply with the Buildings Ordinance (BO) (Cap. 123), detailed fire service requirements will be formulated upon receipt of formal submission of general building plans;
- (h) to note the comments of the Chief Building Surveyor/New Territories West, Buildings Department (CBS/NTW, BD) that:
 - (i) the Site shall be provided with means of obtaining access thereto from a street and emergency vehicular access in accordance with Regulations 5 and 41D of the Building (Planning) Regulations (B(P)R) respectively;
 - (ii) the Site does not abut on a specified street of not less than 4.5m wide and its permitted development intensity shall be determined under Regulation 19(3) of the B(P)R at building plan submission stage;
 - (iii) it is noted that one structure is included in the application. Before any new building works (including containers/open sheds as temporary buildings, demolition and land filling, etc.) are to be carried out on the Site, prior approval and consent of the Building Authority should be obtained, otherwise they are unauthorized building works (UBWs) under the BO. An Authorized Person should be appointed as the coordinator for the proposed building works in accordance with the BO;
 - (iv) if the existing structures are erected on leased land without the approval of the Building Authority, they are UBWs under the BO and should not be designated for any applied use under the captioned application;
 - (v) for UBWs erected on leased land, enforcement action may be taken by BD to effect their removal in accordance with the prevailing enforcement policy against UBW as and when necessary. The granting of any planning approval should not be construed as an acceptance of any existing building works or UBW on the Site under the BO;
 - (vi) any temporary shelters or converted containers for office, storage, washroom or other uses considered as temporary buildings are subject to the control of Part VII of the B(P)R; and
 - (vii) detailed checking under the BO will be carried out at building plan submission stage;

(i) to note the comment of Head of Geotechnical Engineering Office, Civil Engineering and Development Department that:

the applicant is reminded to submit the proposed building works to BD for approval as required under the provisions of BO; and

(i) to note the comments of the Director of Electrical and Mechanical Services that:

in the interests of public safety and ensuring the continuity of electricity supply, the parties concerned with planning, designing, organising and supervising any activity near the underground cable or overhead line under the application should approach the electricity supplier (i.e. CLP Power) for the requisition of cable plans (and overhead line alignment drawings, where applicable) to find out whether there is any underground cable and/or overhead line within and/or in the vicinity of the Site. They should also be reminded to observe the Electricity Supply Lines (Protection) Regulation and the "Code of Practice on Working near Electricity Supply Lines" established under the Regulation when carrying out works in the vicinity of the electricity supply lines.
