**Section 16 Planning Application in Support of the Proposed Redevelopment of China Merchants Godowns and Wharf for Commercial Uses with Minor Relaxation of Gross Floor Area Restriction at Inland Lot 8623 and Adjoining Government Land, 18 Sai Ning Street, Kennedy Town, Hong Kong

Reference is made to the captioned planning application submitted to the Town Planning Board (the Board) on 30 May 2019, the consideration of which was deferred by the Board, on the request by the Applicant, at its meeting on 20 May 2022 pending the submission of further information by the Applicant.
