1. Background

1.1 On 11.4.2024, the applicant sought planning permission for proposed public utility installation (low voltage underground cable) and associated excavation and filling of land at the application site (the Site) (**Plan A-1**).

1.2 On 7.6.2024, the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) of the Town Planning Board (the Board) agreed to defer a decision on the application as requested by the Planning Department until after the Chief Executive in Council has made a decision on the draft San Tin Technopole OZP No. S/STT/1 and the relevant adverse representation(s) 1. The draft OZP is subsequently

¹ On 8.3.2024, the draft San Tin Technopole OZP No. S/STT/1, which covers among others, area excised from the Ngau Tam Mei OZP including the Site, was exhibited under section 5 of the Town Planning Ordinance for public inspection for two months until 8.5.2024. Upon expiry of the exhibition period, a total of 1,543 valid representations were received, including adverse representations covering the whole OZP. The hearings of the representations were held on 28.6.2024, 2.7.2024, 3.7.2024 and 4.7.2024. After giving consideration to the representations, the Board on 19.7.2024 decided not to uphold the representations and that no amendment should be made to the draft OZP to meet the representations.

approved and the approved San Tin Technopole OZP No. S/STT/2 is gazetted on 20.9.2024. The application is scheduled for consideration by the Committee at this meeting.

2. Request for Deferment

On 23.9.2024, the applicant's representative wrote to the Secretary of the Board and requested the Board to defer marking a decision on the application for two months in order to allow more time for preparation of Further Information (FI) to address departmental comments (**Appendix I**).

3. Planning Department's Views

- 3.1 The Planning Department has <u>no objection</u> to the request for deferment as the justifications for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33B) in that the deferment would allow the applicant to prepare FI to address outstanding issues.
- 3.2 Should the Committee agree to defer a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of FI from the applicant. If the FI by the applicant is not substantial and could be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. The applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed two months for preparation of the submission of FI, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances.

4. Decision Sought

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration at the next meeting.
