1. Background

On 4.3.2021, the applicant submitted a planning application for ossuarium and columbarium use at four proposed structures within the existing Tao Fong Shan Christian Cemetery (道風山基督教墳場) compound (**Plan A-1**) to accommodate 1,326 proposed ossuary and ash niches (including 26 existing ossuary/ash niches and 1,300 additional proposed ossuary/ash niches). The application is scheduled for consideration by the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) at this meeting.

2. Request for Deferment

On 2.7.2021, the applicant's representative wrote to the Secretary of the Town Planning Board (the Board) and requested the Board to defer the consideration of the application for two months so as to allow time for the applicant to prepare further information (FI) to address departmental comments (**Appendix I**).

3. Planning Department's View

- 3.1 The Planning Department <u>has no objection</u> to the request for deferment as the justification for deferment meets the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33) in that the applicant needs more time to prepare FI to address departmental comments, the deferment period is not indefinite and the deferment would not affect the interests of other relevant parties.
- 3.2 Should the Committee agree to defer making a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of FI from the applicant. If the FI submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. The applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed two months for preparation of FI submission, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances.

4. Decision Sought

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration at the next meeting.
