<u>Applicant</u>	: Mr. TANG Kam Shing
<u>Site</u>	: Lot 1399 (Part) in D.D. 107 and Adjoining Government Land, Kam Tin, Yuen Long, New Territories
<u>Site Area</u>	: About 850m ² (including Government land of about 486.1m ² (about 57%))
<u>Land Status</u>	: (i) Block Government Lease (demised for agricultural use) (about 43% of the Site) (ii) Government land (about 57% of the Site)
<u>Plan</u>	: Draft Kam Tin North Outline Zoning Plan (OZP) No. S/YL-KTN/10
<u>Zoning</u>	: “Agriculture” (“AGR”)
<u>Application</u>	: Proposed Temporary Holiday Camp with Ancillary Facilities for a Period of 3 Years and Filling of Land

1. Background

On 23.2.2023, the applicant submitted the subject application to seek planning permission for proposed temporary holiday camp with ancillary facilities for a period of 3 years and filling of land at the application site (**Plan A-1**). The application is scheduled for consideration by the Rural and New Town Planning Committee (the Committee) at this meeting.

2. Request for Deferment

On 28.3.2023, the applicant wrote to the Secretary of the Town Planning Board (the Board) and requested the Board to defer making a decision on the application for two months in order to allow time for preparation of further information to address the departmental comments (**Appendix I**).

3. Planning Department’s Views

3.1 The Planning Department has no objection to the request for the first deferment

as the justifications for deferment meet the criteria for deferment as set out in the Town Planning Board Guidelines on Deferment of Decision on Representations, Comments, Further Representations and Applications made under the Town Planning Ordinance (TPB PG-No. 33A) in that the deferment would allow the applicant to prepare further information to address outstanding issue(s).

- 3.2 Should the Committee agree to defer a decision on the application, the application will be submitted to the Committee for consideration within two months upon receipt of further submission from the applicant. If the further information submitted by the applicant is not substantial and can be processed within a shorter time, the application could be submitted to an earlier meeting for the Committee's consideration. The applicant should be advised that the Committee has allowed two months for preparation of the submission of further information, and no further deferment would be granted unless under very special circumstances.

4. Decision Sought

The Committee is invited to consider whether or not to accede to the applicant's request for deferment. If the request is not acceded to, the application will be submitted for the Committee's consideration at the next meeting.
